<p>JERUSALEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On January 3rd 2016, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On November 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the south entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem, which leads to “Armon Hantsiv” settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 22:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Qalandiya village then searched residents and vehicles. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on January 3rd 2016, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village and detained a residents after storming and searching his home and summoned Murad Mohammad Nhisein to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning. (ii) At 11:15, Israeli forces raided Hizma village, clashed with several residents and detained a resident. • <u>Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 19:00, Israeli forces detained Ali Abu Sarhan in Jabal Mukabbir neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (ii) At 24:00, Israeli forces positioned at Hizma checkpoint detained Nuor Salim Al-Shalabi. (iii) Israeli forces detained Milad Ghazi Mohamad Al-Abed Salah Al-Din in Hizman village. (iv) Israeli forces detained Mohammad Muhisen in Al-Eisawiya village.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Assault on Places of Worship:</u> At 09:00, a group of Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli Military and Police forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshippers. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on January 3rd 2015, a group of Israeli settlers set fire to eight vehicles in Al-Thuri neighbourhood in Jerusalem. (ii) At 19:20, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Aqbat Al-Khaldiya area in the old city of Jerusalem and punctured six holes into the outer walls of Ahmad Sab Al-Labbans home after they took over a storage room next to the home approximately 2 week ago. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near “Bet El” settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) Since November 24th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance of Sinjil and the east entrance of Al-Mughier village with cement blocks. (iv) At 18:50 on December 4th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance of Abboud with cement blocks. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. • <u>Raid:</u> At dawn on January 4th 2016, Israeli forces raided Barta'a Al-Sharqiya village detained a resident after storming and searching his home. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.

TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 11:05, and again at 21:40 Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 16:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Shufa village then prevented residents and vehicles from passing through the checkpoint. • <u>Raid:</u> At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem until 03:25.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds (iv) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 23:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya then searched residents and vehicles. • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:10, Israeli forces raided Qalqiliya until 01:40. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al-Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama’ located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za’tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Salfit then searched residents and vehicles until 10:00. (ii) At 12:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafil Harris village and temporarily detained Mahmoud Amin Nimr (A resident of Qirat village) then released him later. (ii) At 10:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Jiftlik village junction and temporarily detained Moath Abu Al-Rub (A National Security Force Officer) then released him at 11:05. • <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 17:45, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge temporarily detained Ali Firas Ali Sayfi then released him after preventing him from travelling to Jordan.

(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla. (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires. (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds. (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds. (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds. (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002 } and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases. (ix) Since 10:45 on September 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the agricultural road located in Arab Al-Rashaydeh village located near "Malee Amous" settlement with dirt mounds. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jinata then searched residents and vehicles until 09:45. (ii) At 08:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the west entrance of Taqou' Jinata then searched residents and vehicles until 12:00. (iii) At 08:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Nashash area junction located at the south entrance of Bethlehem then searched residents and vehicles until 11:30.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:40, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem, Al-Duhisheh camp and Al-Doha , clashed with several residents as they stormed and searched several homes and as a result injured 6 residents including 4 children: Hassan Iyas Shahin (14 years old), Ibrahim Mohammad Assad (13 years old), Mohammad Haytham Abu Ajamiya (14 years old), Sa'ed Ahed Eid Abu Amr (13 years old), Jameel Khalil Ziyadeh, and Mufti Ma'rouf Omaro and then detained 2 residents and levelled a plot of land near Osama AlAjouris' home located in Jabal Handazah area then withdrew at 13:30. (ii) At 18:55, Israeli forces raided Harsa area located in east Beit Sahour, stormed a Mosque then withdrew at 19:15. (iii) At 00:55, Israeli forces raided Beit Fajjar, stormed several homes and summoned 4 residents: Khaled Tariq Taqatqa, Khalil Na'im Taqatqa ,Adel Salah Taqatqa and Ahmad Nour Taqatqa then withdrew at 01:50. (iv) At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem and Al-Ayda camp and summoned three residents: Mohammad Attalah Al-Mashayikh, Hamza Yusef Al-Masa'ed and Mohammad Taysir Al-Mashayikh to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 03:45. • <u>Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:55, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in Bethlehem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. (ii) At 20:10, Israeli forces positioned near Nihalin village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Raed Khaled Abu Hadid and Hamza Osama Al-Ajouri in Bethlehem.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed. (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages. (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks. (v) At 05:50 on November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks. (vi) At 10:30 on November 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the junction located near "Hagi" settlement located in south Hebron with cement blocks. (vii) At 21:00 on November 11th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Beit Awwa and Al-Majd village with cement block and dirt mounds.

- (viii) At 15:45 on November 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Samiya village junction located at the west entrance of Al-Samou' with cement blocks.
- (ix) On November 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Khliat Al-Miya and Al Dirat and the two bypass roads leading east Yatta with cement blocks.
- (x) On November 23rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Qom village located in North Beit Awwa with Cement blocks.
- (xi) On December 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed a checkpoint located along Al-Shuhada road located in the old city of Hebron and prevented residents from passing through the checkpoint and redirected traffic through a road near the entrance of Jabal Al-Rahma .
- (xii) On December 9th 2015, Israeli forces closed a road near Jabal Jallis area located in the old city of Hebron and closed the bypass road.
- **Flying Checkpoint:**
 - (i) At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Hebron located along road35 near Halhoul Bridge then searched residents and vehicles.
 - (ii) At 18:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Yatta and Al-Samou' then searched residents and vehicles.
 - (iii) At 18:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Zif village junction then searched residents and vehicles.
 - (iv) At 18:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Fah's area located in south Hebron and prevented residents from entering the area until reopening the gate at a later time.

 - (i) At 14:45, Israeli forces raided Hebron (for the alleged shooting incident towards Israeli soldier near the old city of Hebron which wounded a female soldier) and occupied several homes and converted their rooftops into military posts and again at 01:30 and detained a residents after storming and searching his home then withdrew at 05:30.
 - (ii) At 00:40, Israeli forces raided Al-Shiyoukh.
 - **Attack:**
 - At 19:30, Israeli forces positioned in Shuhada Street in the old city of Hebron fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
 - **Detention:**
 - (i) At 00:40 on January 3rd 2016, Israeli forces detained Mohammad Sameer Atiyah Obidou during their raid into Hebron as mentioned in the previous report.
