<p style="text-align: center;"><b>ALL DISTRICTS</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.</li> </ul>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>JERUSALEM</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li> <p><b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrances to Al Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque.</p> </li> <li> <p><b>Closure of Main Roads:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al Bareed to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt barricades the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.</li> </ul> </li> <li> <p><b>Checkpoints:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.</li> <li>(ii) At 09:00, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Ramot checkpoint and impeded civilian access.</li> </ul> </li> <li> <p><b>Wall Gates:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> <li> <p><b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Bareed, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.</p> </li> <li> <p><b>Flying Checkpoint:</b> At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Beit Duqqu and searched civilians and vehicles.</p> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 21:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Biddu.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army raided the village of Hizma and arrested 2 civilians.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Arrests:</u></b> The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the village of Hizma: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Muhannad ‘Awwad al Khatib; and</li> <li>(ii) Mustafa Ahmed al Khatib.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>RAMALLAH &amp; EL BIREH</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Saffa.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close the settler bypass road connecting ‘Assur Hill in the village of Kafr Malik to Alon settler bypass road.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of ‘Atara and to impede civilian access.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction continues in the area west of the town of ‘Abud as well as in the areas of Al Midya to Ni’lin and Ni’lin to Deir Qaddis.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of Deir Abu Mash’al, searched civilians and vehicles, and impeded civilian access.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raids/Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At dawn on 04 June 2007, the Israeli army raided the town of ‘Abud and arrested 1 civilian.</li> <li>(ii) At 07:30 on 04 June 2007, the Israeli army raided the village of Saffa and detained Ahlam Riyadh Nasser, an 11-year-old female child, while she was going to school. The Israeli army also blindfolded Ahlam, put her in a jeep, and released her at a later time.</li> <li>(iii) At 00:10, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of El Bireh.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Arrest:</u></b> The Israeli army arrested Dawoud Mustafa Abu Hussein in the town of ‘Abud.</li> </ul>
<b>JENIN</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Roads:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the unpaved detour roads leading to the town of ‘Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan.</li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints/Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:40, the Israeli army set up 5 flying checkpoints: 1 at the southern entrance to the city of Jenin; 3 at the entrances to the town of Qabatiya; and 1 on the junction to the village of Al Jarba. Israeli troops positioned at these flying checkpoints searched civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<p>(ii) At 09:30, and again at 02:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the town Az Zababida, arrested 1 civilian, detained Kamal Mohammed Jalamneh, a Palestinian National Security officer, and released him at a later time.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Raids/Attack/Injuries/Medical Obstruction/Provocation of Pal. Forces:</u></b></li> </ul> <p>(i) At 14:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Az Zababida as well as the villages of ‘Aqqaba and Al Kufeir.</p> <p>(ii) At 14:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Jenin.</p> <p>(iii) At 01:30, the Israeli army, including 6 jeeps, raided and patrolled the town of Tubas.</p> <p>(iv) At 03:00, the Israeli army, including 30 jeeps and 1 bulldozer, raided the town of Qabatiya. An armed confrontation took place between the Israeli army and armed Palestinian individuals. While searching a number of houses, confrontations also took place between the Israeli army and civilians, during which the Israeli army injured 3 civilians, including 1 child. In addition, the Israeli army denied access to an ambulance to transport the injured civilians, except after coordination with the Israeli authorities (through the DCO). Furthermore, the Israeli army arrested 8 civilians, took position near the town’s Palestinian Police station as well as near Palestinian Police officers guarding the Palestinian Ministry of Education District Office. <p><b>TULKAREM</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district.</li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal’a road; the entrance to the village of Saffarin; the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to ‘Attil plain; the road connecting the town of Kafr al Labad to the village of Shufa; the road to the town of Deir al Ghusun’s plain; and the entrance to the village of ‘Izbat Abu Khamish.</li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem) as well as at ‘Einav checkpoint (the eastern entrance to the city).</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:50, Israeli army infantry forces raided and combed the area of Wadi al Hassin between the towns of 'Illar, Deir al Ghusun, and 'Attil. At 12:00, the Israeli army infantry forces withdrew from the area.</li> <li>(ii) At 19:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Bal'a and searched a number of barracks.</li> <li>(iii) At 20:20, the Israeli army raided and combed the area of Byar 'Ashur between the town of Bal'a and the village of Al 'Attara.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Arrests:</u></b> At 02:00 on 04 June 2007, the Israeli army arrested 3 civilians during its raid into the village of Zeita: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Majdi Salah Yaseen;</li> <li>(ii) Abdul Baset Nasser Abu al 'Izz; and</li> <li>(iii) Mahmoud Ahmed Balqis.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>QALQILIYA</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Roads:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun as well as the road connecting the town of 'Azzun to the village of 'Izbat at Tabib.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Jit and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(ii) At 11:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance to the town of 'Azzun, closed the entrance with an iron gate, and denied civilian access.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raid/Curfew:</u></b> At 13:00, the Israeli army raided the town of 'Azzun and imposed curfew, allegedly for throwing stones at Israeli settler vehicles travelling along the Qalqiliya-Nablus main road.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> A group of Israeli settlers set fire to civilian olive groves in the village of Jit.</li> </ul>
<b>NABLUS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of Al Lubban ash Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus:</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Huwwara and Beit Iba checkpoints (set up at the southern and western entrances to the city of Nablus respectively) are closed at 23:00. The Israeli army only allows civilian vehicles possessing access permits to cross these checkpoints. The Israeli army also searches civilians using metal detectors at Beit Iba checkpoint, impeding their access.</li> <li>(ii) At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jirzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighbourhood only.</li> <li>(iii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the village of Beit Dajan until 17:30.</li> <li>(iv) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira ash Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases.</li> <li>(v) At 08:00, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus and denied access to civilians between 16 and 30 years of age. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the settlement of Yitzhar and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raids/Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 01:15, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus as well as Balata and 'Askar refugee camps, searched a number of houses, arrested 3 civilians, and withdrew at 05:15.</li> <li>(ii) At 05:30, the Israeli army raided the villages of Salim and Deir al Hatab and opened indiscriminate fire, while patrolling the area.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Arrests:</u></b> The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the city of Nablus and in the refugee camps of Balata and 'Askar: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Ahmed an Nabils; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(ii) Abdul Rahman 'Ashour; and <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(iii) Mohammed Yousef ash Shobaki.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> </li> </ul> </li> </ul> </li></ul>
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army has continued to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising).</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and, with cement blocks, the western entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut checkpoint and to deny civilian access to the town of Kafr ad Dik.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the Za'tara junction checkpoint and to impede civilian access.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Raid:</b> At 17:00, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the village of Yasuf. While patrolling the area, confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians. At 17:20, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.</li> </ul>
<b>JERICHO</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs.</li> <li>• <b>Checkpoints:</b> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at Al Hamra checkpoint set up along Al Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of Al 'Auja along Al Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.</li> <li>• <b>Arrests:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 09:30, Israeli troops positioned on al Karama (Allenby) Bridge arrested Khaled Mahmoud 'Ilayyan, Chairman of Deir al Ghusun Municipality in the district of Tulkarem, while he was returning from Jordan.</li> <li>(ii) At 10:00, Israeli troops positioned on Al Karama (Allenby) Bridge arrested Basem Abdul Rahman Abu ar Rub, a civilian resident of the town of Qabatiya in the district of Jenin. The Israeli Intelligence agency also informed Abu ar Rub's family that he would stay in custody until his brother, Mu'tassem, surrenders himself to the Israeli army.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>BETHLEHEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Closure:</b> The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.</li> <li>• <b>Closure of Main Roads:</b> The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.</li> <li>• <b>Wall Construction:</b> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of Al Khadr, northwest of the city of Beit Jala, and in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Efrat.</li> <li>• <b>Flying Checkpoints:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 21:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Tuqu' and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(ii) At 00:25, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints at the western and southern entrances to the town of Beit Fajjar and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b>Attack:</b> At 04:40, the Israeli army fired flares over 'Ayda refugee camp.</li> <li>• <b>Raids/Attack:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 22:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Beit Ta'mir.</li> <li>(ii) At 04:20, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Fajjar and searched 1 house.</li> <li>(iii) At 05:40, the Israeli army raided the city of Beit Jala and fired flares, while combing the area near the Wall.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Air Patrol:</u></b> At 23:00, Israeli combat helicopters patrolled the skies over the town of Jannata.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>HEBRON</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of Al Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access to and from the area.</li> <li>(ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of As Samoa'; the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of Al Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to Al 'Arrub refugee camp.</li> <li>(ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of Ar Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.</li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 11:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Al Fawwar refugee camp and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass to the town of Halhul, searched civilians and vehicles, and arrested 1 civilian.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Raids:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 23:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Yatta, searched 1 house, and arrested 1 civilian.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
