WEST BANK

• Closure:

- (i) On September 4th 2015,the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers in Al-Aqsa mosque compound except for Women over the age of 55, Permit holders and men ages 50.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.

• Checkpoints:

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 11:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Al-Eizariya located near "Malee Adumin" settlement junction.

• Attack:

- (i) At 17:10, Israeli forces positioned in Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ii) At 23:10, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ram junction fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- **<u>Detention:</u>** On the evening of September 4th 2015, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Jerusalem detained 2 residents: Mohammad Al-Taweel and Mohammad Al-Bibi.
- <u>Demonstration:</u> At 14:00, a demonstration took place near the entrance of Al-Rahma Cemetery located near the east area of Al-Aqsa mosque compound protesting against the Israeli confiscation of 40% of the area for the purpose of constructing a "Talmudic Park".

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. At 21:40 on June 30th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near "Bet EI" settlement which leads to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. At 13:25, Israeli forces closed a bypass road leading to Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds. Raid: At 11:40, Israeli forces raided Beit Illu for the alleged firing towards a settler vehicle then withdrew at 12:00. Attack: Attack: At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance "Ofar" Military base/ Prison fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. At 16:45, Israeli forces positioned near Atarah bridge located in North Bir Zeit fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. Demonstrations: At 13:40, a demonstration took place in Bil'in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation. At 13:45, a demonstration took place in Ni'lin protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation. At 13:45, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against the confiscation of land for the purpose of settlement construction during which they clashed with Israeli forces who fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators and as a result left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation and also temporarly detained 5 residents including a Woman and a Journalist: Lamma Naz
JENIN	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. Flying Checkpoint: At 19:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at T'inik village junction. Raid: At 16:30, Israeli forces raided Al-Arqa village. On the evening of September 4th 2015, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad, stormed and searched a local Girls school. At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Yamoun. Detention: On September 4th 2015, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Jamala crossing point located along the Green Line in North Jenin detained Mohammad Jarrar (A resident of Jenin). Wall Gates: Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TULKAREM	<u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic.

_	• Raid: (i) At 02:05, Israeli forces raided Anabta, stormed 3 Merchant shops and a Gas station and confiscated surveillance camera footage during which they clashed with several residents and as a result injured Mohammad Barakat and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions then withdrew at 04:40.
	(ii) At 04:00, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem until 04:55.
QALQILIYA	Closure of Roads: (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed a agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds Raid: (i) At 16:40, Israeli forces raided Azzun, Asalah and Izbit Al-Tabib villages for the alleged gun fire towards the bypass road in the area. (ii) At 18:55, Israeli forces raided the area located between Immatin and Far'ata villages, opened fire towards the area then withdrew at 19:10. Demonstration: At 12:10, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces who tried to disrupt the demonstration who fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators who attempted to reach they demonstration site and as a result injured 2 residents: Riyad Ishtewi and Riziq Ishtewi and also left several residents suffocating form tear gas inhalation. Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
	 Closure: Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. Flying Checkpoint:
NABLUS	 (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Burin village junction until 17:10. (ii) At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Beit Furiq and Beit Dajjan until 21:10. (iii) At 23:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint between Orif and Einbuis villages.

	• Raid: (i) At 15:30, Israeli forces raided Burin village until 16:30. (ii) At 15:35, Israeli forces raided Al-Naqura village until 16:25. (iii) At 23:30, Israeli forces raided Orif village.
SALFIT	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. Checkpoints: At 19:20, Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint, impeded the free flow of traffic and detained 2 residents including a Preventive Security Force officer for allegedly finding an M-16 assault rifle and impeded the free flow of traffic until 21:30. Detention: Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint detained Mahmoud Mahrouq and Raed Qutmi (A resident of Al-Jalazoun camp).
JERICHO	 Checkpoints: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. Flying Checkpoint: At 18:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Road (90) junction located near Nuwe'meh village near the North entrance of Jericho until 19:25. Raid: At 10:15, Israeli forces raided Jericho as they escorted a group of Israeli settlers who stormed a Synagogue in the area then withdrew at 11:30. Physical Assault: At 19:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Hamra checkpoint assaulted Shadi Abu Amshah (A resident of Zuwata village in Nablus) and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks. (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
BETHLEHEM	between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.

- area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.

• Raid:

- (i) At 21:15, Israeli forces raided Khirbeit Al-Dier village near Taqou', stormed 3 homes then withdrew at 22:10.
- (ii) At 03:00, Israeli forces raided Jurat Al-Sham'a village until 03:50.
- (iii) At 03:55, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem until 04:50.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to closed Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

HEBRON

- **Raid:** At 01:55, Israeli forces raided Dura, clashed with several residents as they stormed a home and injured a resident as they detained him then withdrew at 03:45.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Ra'fat Abu Al-Sabagh in Dura.

• Temporary Detention:

- (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Uroub camp temporarily detained the child: Rabah Fadilat (16 years old) then released him at 14:10.
- (ii) At 20:00, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of Hebron temporarily detained the child Hassan Al-Batsh (12 years old) then released him at 03:40.
- Physical Assault: At 00:30, Israeli forces positioned in Tel Al-Rumayda neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron assaulted Jadawi Abu Haykal (A University student) and sprayed pepper spray onto his face and as a result left him hospitalised with contusions of suffocation.

• Settler Violence: At 08:55, a group of Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in
Barqa and Safa area' allocated in Halhoul the withdrew at 12:30.

ALL DISTRICTS	• At 19:00 on August 26 th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
NORTHERN GAZA	Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decisions.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
