#### **WEST BANK**

#### ALL DISTRICTS

• The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

# • <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrances to the Al Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al Bareed to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho.
- <u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem.

#### • Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction was resumed in Dahiyat al Bareed, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna.
- <u>Raid</u>: At 15:30, Israeli Special Forces raided the town Ar Ram and arrested 1 civilian.
- <u>Arrest</u>: Israeli Special Forces arrested Tawfiq as Salaymeh in the town of Ar Ram.

#### **JERUSALEM**

#### **Closure of Main Roads:** The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern (i) entrance to the village of Sinjil as well as the road to the village of Ras Karkar. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western (ii) entrance to the village of Saffa. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede civilian access. Wall Construction: Wall construction was resumed in the area west of the town of 'Abud as well as in the areas of Al Midya to Ni'lin and Ni'lin to Deir Qaddis. RAMALLAH Flying Checkpoint/Physical Assault: At 22:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the village of 'Ajjul, searched civilians & **EL BIREH** and vehicles, and beat 3 civilians, leaving them with injuries. All 3 civilians were admitted to Ramallah Public Hospital for medical treatment. (i) At 12:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of El Bireh. At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Abu Shukheidim and (ii) searched 1 house. (iii) At 02:20, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the village of Qarawat Bani Zeid, searched 1 house, and served a summons to a Palestinian Police officer to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency. At 02:35, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. The Israeli army raided the village of Surda and arrested 1 civilian. Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Hamzeh Khaled ar Ramahi in the village of Surda. <u>Closure of Roads</u>: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the unpaved detour roads leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. **Wall Gates:** Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special (i) **JENIN** Israeli permits. Beginning on 29 March 2007, the Israeli army has continued to (ii) regulate times to open Al Jalama and Salim Wall gates between 06:30 until 10:00 and 17:00 until 21:00 respectively. **Flying Checkpoints:** The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the (i) village of Deir Abu Da'if and searched civilians and vehicles. The Israeli army set up 4 flying checkpoints: 3 on the junctions to the (ii) towns of 'Arraba and Az Zababida and the village of Al Kufeir as well as 1 in the area between the town of 'Arraba and the village of Fahma.

- Israeli troops positioned at these flying checkpoints searched civilians and vehicles.
- (iii) The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Al Jarba, searched civilians and vehicles, and arrested 1 civilian.

#### • Raids/Attack/Injuries:

- (i) At 00:45, the Israeli army, including 8 jeeps and 1 bulldozer, raided the city of Jenin and Jenin refugee camp. In the refugee camp, an armed confrontation took place between the Israeli army and armed Palestinian individuals, during which the Israeli army injured and arrested 1 civilian and 1 Palestinian National Security officer.
- (ii) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Kafr Ra'i, after having closed its entrances with flying checkpoints. In addition, the Israeli army searched a number of houses and patrolled the area until 08:00.
- (iii) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Tubas.

#### • Arrests:

- (i) At 03:20 on 05 May 2007, the Israeli army arrested Abdul Rahman Zuheir Bal'awi, a Palestinian National Security officer, during its raid into the city of Jenin.
- (ii) Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of Al Jarba arrested Jum'ah Turkman.

The Israeli army arrested 1 civilian and 1 Palestinian security officer in Jenin refugee camp:

- (iii) Mohammed Abu al 'Abbas, a Palestinian National Security officer; and
- (iv) Ahmed Ibrahim Abu Ali.

### • <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district.

- Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road, the entrance to the village of Saffarin, the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil plain, the road connecting the town of Kafr al Labad to the village of Shufa, and the road to the town of Deir al Ghusun's plain.
- <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem) as well as at 'Einav checkpoint (the eastern entrance to the city).
- <u>Wall Gates</u>: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.
- <u>Flying Checkpoints</u>: At 10:00, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints, one at the southern entrance to the town of 'Attil and the other on the junction to the village of Al Jarushiya, searched civilians and vehicles, and impeded civilian access until 11:00.

#### • Raids/Attack:

- (i) At 01:15, the Israeli army, including 4 jeeps, raided Tulkarem refugee camp, opened indiscriminate fire, arrested 1 civilian, and withdrew at 01:30.
- (ii) At 01:45, the Israeli army, including 7 jeeps, raided Nur Shams refugee camp and patrolled the area until 02:15.

NABLUS	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron.

	• <u>Checkpoints</u> : The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing

(ii) At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jirzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighbourhood only. Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit (iii) Furik and the village of Beit Dajan until 17:30. (iv) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira ash Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases. (v) At 08:00, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at the checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus and denied access to civilians between 16 and 30 years of age. Flying Checkpoint: At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Yitzhar and searched civilians and vehicles. Raids/House Occupations/Attack/Injury/Detentions: At 20:40, the Israeli army raided the villages of Salim and Deir al (i) Hatab. While patrolling the village of Salim, confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians. At 01:05, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus, occupied the roofs (ii) of a number of houses in the old city of Nablus, converted them into military posts, and opened indiscriminate fire, injuring 1 civilian. At 05:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. The Israeli army raided the village of Madama. While patrolling the (iii) area, the Israeli army detained a number of civilians and released them at a later time. **Settler Violence:** At 13:50, a group of Israeli settlers raided the village of Al Lubban ash Sharqiya and attempted to seize control of a civilian house. At 16:00, the Israeli army evacuated the settlers from the area. **Closure of Main Roads:** (i) The Israeli army has continued to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current Intifada (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and, with cement blocks, the western entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik. At 10:00, the closed with dirt barricades and cement blocks the road (iii) **SALFIT** connecting the villages of Iskaka and Yasuf (the eastern entrance to the city of Salfit). However, civilians reopened the road at 11:40. **Checkpoints:** The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut (i) checkpoint and to deny civilian access to the town of Kafr ad Dik. The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the Za'tara (ii) junction checkpoint and to impede civilian access. Wall Construction: Wall construction was resumed in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris

north of the settlement of Ari'el.

JERICHO	<ul> <li>Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs.</li> <li>Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at Al Hamra checkpoint set up along Al Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of Al 'Auja along Al Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.</li> <li>Flying Checkpoint: At 01;00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the intersection of Road # 90 in the centre of the village of Al 'Auja and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul>

- (v) At 03:30, the Israeli army, including 8 jeeps, raided Ad Duheisha refugee camp in the city of Bethlehem, searched 1 house, and withdrew at 05:30.
- Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the town of Al 'Ubeidiya:
- (i) Mas'oud Mohammed al 'Assa; and
- (ii) Yasser Mohammed al 'Assa.
- (iii) The Israeli army arrested 'Adman Kayed Jibreen in the town of Tuqu'.
- <u>Palestinian Security Measure</u>: At 16:00, Palestinian security forces handed over to the Israeli authorities (through the DCO) Yaakov Yahin, an Israeli citizen, after he mistakenly entered the town of Al 'Ubeidiya.

#### • <u>Closure</u>:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of Al Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access to and from the area.
- (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

#### • Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of As Samoa'; the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of Al Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to Al 'Arrub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction was resumed in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of Ar Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

#### **HEBRON**

- **Flying Checkpoints:** At 10:30, and again at 18:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the overpass to the town of Halhul and searched civilians and vehicles. At 18:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.
- Raids:
- (i) At 17:50, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, set up a checkpoint, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area.
- (ii) At 00:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Halhul.
- (iii) At 02:20, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Adh Dhahiriya.
- <u>Destruction of Property</u>: At 15:30, Israeli troops positioned on the military watchtower erected at the entrance to the town of Beit Ummar fired sound grenades, causing damage to the windows of a civilian house.

#### **GAZA STRIP**

#### ALL DISTRICTS

- The ceasefire agreement that entered into force at 06:00 on 26 November 2006 remains effective. However, the Israeli army opened fire towards Palestinian territory on 4 occasions. The Israeli army also carried out 4 raids into Palestinian territory, during which it arrested 2 armed Palestinian individuals and levelled land on 2 occasions. In addition, Israeli combat helicopters patrolled the skies over Palestinian territory on 1 occasion. Moreover, armed Palestinian individuals opened fire towards Israeli troops on the Green Line north of the town of Beit Lahiya as well as fired 4 mortars towards the Green Line, of which 1 mortar landed on Palestinian territory.
- <u>Closure of Crossing Point</u>: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open to foreign nationals, humanitarian cases, and VIPs.
- Attack/Palestinian Attack: At 14:00, in violation of the Israeli-Palestinian ceasefire agreement, the Israeli army opened fire from one of its locations on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory north of Al Qarya al Badawiya north of the town of Beit Lahiya, after armed Palestinian individuals opened fire towards Israeli troops.
- <u>Raids/Attack/Injuries</u>: In violation of the Israeli-Palestinian ceasefire agreement, the Israeli army raided Palestinian territory, as follows:

#### NORTHERN GAZA

- (i) At 09:10, Israeli Special Forces raided Palestinian territory west of Al Qarya al Badawiya north of the town of Beit Lahiya and opened intensive fire, injuring 1 armed Palestinian individual. Israeli Special Forces also arrested 2 armed Palestinian individuals, including the injured individual. At 19:30, Israeli Special Forces withdrew from the area.
- (ii) At 14:10, the Israeli army, including 10 armoured vehicles, raided 300 metres into Palestinian territory near Point 14 on the Green Line north of the town of Beit Lahiya and withdrew at 19:30.
- <u>Arrests</u>: Israeli Special Forces arrested 2 armed Palestinian individuals west of Al Qarya al Badawiya north of the town of Beit Lahiya:
- (i) Mohammed Qarmout; and
- (ii) Bakr Abdul Ra'ouf Abu Shaqfeh.
