Closure: (i) On June 5 th 2014, The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound (In Commemoration with the 47 anniversary of Al-Naksa (Israeli occupation of the West Bank and Gaza). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoints.

- (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Raid:** At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Anata then stormed and searched a home.
- <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 13:15, Israeli forces positioned in east Mikhmas village temporarily detained Mahmoud Malihat (10 years old) then released him at a later time.
- <u>Obstruction of Places of Worship:</u> On June 5th 2015, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers.
- <u>Settlement Activity</u>: On June 5th 2014, Israeli authorities approved the construction of 1800 settlement unites { 500 in "Brujin" settlement, 381 in "Jivat Zaif" settlement, 38 im "Mitan" settlement, 25 in "Kokhav Yacoub" settlement, 54 in "Lavi Minsha" settlement, 10 in "Tusfit" settlement and 683 in "Eli Zahav" settlements located in Jerusalem, Qalqiliya and Salfit all on land occupied in 1967.

• Demonstration:

- (i) At 14:15, a demonstration took place near Qalandiya checkpoint located in North Jerusalem in commemoration of the 47th anniversary of Al-Naksa {Israeli's occupation of the West Bank and Gaza} and in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets , stun and tear gas grenades towards several demonstrators and as a result injured 4 residents and left several other suffocating from tear gas inhalation.
- (ii) On the evening of June 5th 2014, a demonstration took place near Bab Al-Amoud gate in the old city of Jerusalem in commemoration of the 47th anniversary of Al-Naksa {Israeli's occupation of the West Bank and Gaza} and in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons during which Israeli forces fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several demonstrators.

• Wall Gates:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
- Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim.

• Closure of Main Roads:

RAMALLAH & AL BIREH

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages.
- (ii) Since September 3rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the north east entrance of Al-Mughier village with dirt mounds.
- (iii) Since 00:20 on March 4th 2014, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Al-Jalazun camp and Bet El settlement with cement blocks.

• Flying Checkpoints:

	 (i) Atara Bridge located in North Bir Zeit. (ii) At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along the main road leading to Al-Jalazun camp near "Bet El "settlement until 21:20. (iii) At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Abu Mash'al village until 22:20. Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in the area west of 'Abud town in the area surrounding the illegal settlement 'Ofarim and north of Al-Lubban Al-Gharbi and Rantis villages.
JENIN	 Closure of Main Road: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. Raid: At 21:10, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad and detained 2 children then withdrew at 23:30. Detention: Israeli forces detained 2 children: Hussein Hirzallah (15 years old) and Mahmoud Hamarsheh (14 years old) in Ya'bad. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall.
TULKAREM	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village. The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road. Checkpoint: Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic. Raid: At 21:20, Israeli forces raided Tulkarem. Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is prevented to civilians granted special Israeli permits, which undercuts the access to education and health services for civilians living behind the Wall then allowed them to pass through at 09:30.
QALQILIYA	 Closure of Roads: (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. Temporary Detention: At 15:00, Israeli forces positioned in east Azzun temporally detained 3 residents including a child: Mohammad Mazid (15 years old), Yasser Badran and Mahmoud Qishta as they were collecting scrap metal in the area then released them at 15:45. Wall Gates: (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate. Wall Construction: Wall construction resumed in Kafr Laqif village north of Karnei Shomron settlement; in Immatin village northeast of Immanuel settlement; and east of Kafr Thulth town near Ma 'ale Shomron settlement.

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
- (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds.
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 12:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Dar Salah village located at the east entrance of Beit Sahur until 23:00.
- **Raid:** At 00:50, Israeli forces raided Bethlehem.
- <u>Demonstration</u>: At 11:00, a demonstration took place near the Church of Nativity in Bethlehem in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons.

• Wall Construction:

- (i) Wall construction resumed in North West of Beit Jala town.
- (ii)On May $1^{\rm st}$ 2103, an Israeli court ordered the halt of wall construction near Betar village.
- (iii) On July 21st 2013, Israeli courts ordered the halt of construction of the wall in Al-Carmisan area in the west area of Beit Jalla.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction,

the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area. .

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.
- (vi) Since December 27th 2012, Israeli forces closed the west entrance of Swiesiya village which connects Yatta and Al-Samou' village with cement blocks.
- (vii) Since 09:45 on September 23rd 2013, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to "Haji" settlement and impeded the free flow of traffic.
- (viii) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces opened a steel gate in Beit Anun.
- (ix) Since March 9th 2014, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Al-Rihana area in east Yatta.
- <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ummar and confiscated Aisha Aghnimates identification card.
- **Raid:** At 19:45, Israeli forces raided Halhul, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 20:40.
- <u>Attack:</u> At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned at Halhul Bridge fired tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning.
- Home Occupation: At 09:10, Israeli forces stormed Al-Zahad area in the old city
 of Hebron and occupied Zakariya Yaghmour's home and converted its rooftop
 into a military post.
- <u>Confiscation of Property:</u> At 15:00, Israeli forces confiscated 10 Mobile bathrooms, 8 water tanks (holding 1500 litter of water) and 3 trucks owned by Young Christian Association in Sai'r in Hebron.
- **<u>Demonstration</u>**: At 14:00, a demonstration took place in the old city of Hebron in commemoration of the 47th anniversary of Al-Naksa {Israeli's occupation of the West Bank and Gaza} and in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons during which Israeli forces fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several demonstrators and as a result injured 4 residents and left several other suffocating from tear gas inhalation and detained a resident.
- **Detention:** Israeli forces detained Fihmi Shahin in the old city of Hebron.
- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction resumed in the area surrounding the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. Israeli Naval vessels broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.

Attack: On the morning of June 6th 2014, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats as the apprehended them off the shores of Beit Lahiya.
GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points: Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shuja'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
