WEST BANK

JERUSALEM	 Closure: The Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 40 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound. The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. Checkpoints: Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. Attack: At 00:15, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint in Jerusalem fired stun and tear gas grenades towards residents and vehicles passing through the checkpoint. Wall Gates: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
RAMALLAH & AL BIREH	 Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and 'Ein Samiya villages. At 18:50 on January 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the area between Al-Mughier village and a by pas road and the main road between Al-Mughier and Duma villages with dirt mounds. Raid: At 16:15 and again at 02:50, Israeli forces raided Beituniya, clashed with several residents, and temporarily detained a child: Mohammad Tanatrah (13 years old) then released him later and withdrew at 04:20. Attack: At 14:25, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several children for alleged stoning. Land Levelling: At 10:00, Israeli forces stormed a plot of land near the entrance gate of Beitin, which has been closed since the year 2000 and levelled a plot of land. Settler Violence:

	(i) At 10:00, a group of Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land in Al-
	Mazra'a Al-Gharbiya and assaulted Rasim Shartih as he was farming his
	land and stole several ploughing tools.
	(ii) At 11:30, a group of Israeli settlers stormed in the area between Kafr
	Malik and Deir Jreir villages and installed several mobile homes on
	residential owned land and herded their goats in the area.
	Closure of Main Road: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25 th 2012, Israeli forces closed the
JENIN	western entrance of Ya'bad.
	• Flying Checkpoint: At 18:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ya'bad until 02:00.
	• Raid: At 00:15, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad then stormed and searched four
	homes.
TUBAS	• <u>Flying checkpoint:</u> At 19:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Tamoun and Khirbeit Atouf until 19:50.
	Closure of Main Roads:
TULKAREM	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road connecting Kafr Al-Labad town to Shufa village.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the detour road leading to Ramin village along the Tulkarem-Nablus main road.
	• <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic.
	Closure of Roads:
	(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.
	(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.
	(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18 th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds
	• Attack: At 17:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Marouj area located in east
	Azzun fired stun grenades towards several children for alleged stoning.
	• Wall Gates:
QALQILIYA	(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate
	and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close
	with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to
	deny civilian access.
	(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109.
	Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the
	Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the
	village through the Habla gate.

	• <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17 th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.
	• Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the
	village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut.
	• Flying Checkpoint: At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Beit Furiq junction until 22:25.
NABLUS	Settler Violence: (i) At 11:40, a group of Israeli settlers stormed Jabal Al-Rakha and Jabal Qweik areas located in south Jallud village and installed five mobile homes on residential owned land.
	(ii) At 13:15, an armed Israeli settler positioned in south Aqraba junction opened fire towards residents and vehicles.
	Closure of Main Roads:
	 (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. (ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20.
SALFIT	 (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. Checkpoints: At 14:35, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at
	 Za'tara checkpoint and imped the free flow of traffic. Raid: At 18:30, Israeli forces raided Salfit. At 18:50, Israeli forces raided Masaha village until 19:05. Temporary Detention: At 22:20, Israeli forces positioned at Za'tara checkpoint junction temporarily detained Adel Rabay'a (A resident of Maythaloun in Jenin) then released him at 22:30.
	<u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District.
JERICHO	Flying Checkpoint: (i) At 08:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Road (90) junction located near Nuwe'meh village at the north entrance of Jericho until 10:00. (ii) At 22:40 and again at 06:25, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the south entrance of Jericho, temporarily detained Yahya Ayad(A resident of Hebron) then released him after summoning him to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning until 07:00.
ветніенем	Closure: (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.
	(ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities.
	Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road leading to "Newe Daniyyel" settlement and agricultural land in Al-Khader; a road between Um Tuba and Wadi Al-Hums: Wadi Fukin, Al-Jaba, the Green Line; a road between Za'tara and a detour road, and a road between Taqou and Khirbet Al-Deir with cement blocks.
- (iii) Since August 2nd 2012, Israeli forces closed a road leading to Beit Jalla.
- (iv) Since May 8th 2013, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Carmisan area in Beit Jalla and Al-Walaja with a steel gate and barbed wires.
- (v) Since June 3rd 2013, the Israeli army closed the road connecting Nihalin and road 60 with dirt mounds.
- (vi) Since 13:20 on September 29th 2013, the Israeli army closed a road leading to 50 acres of agricultural land in Wadi Salem area in Al-Khadr with dirt mounds.
- (vii) Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Surif and Al-Jub'a village with dirt mounds
- (viii) On January 28th 2014, Israeli forces closed the steel gate at the entrance of Nihalin { replacing the dirt mounds placed at the entrance since the year 2002} and placed time schedule for opening the gate from 06:00 until 14:00 on a daily bases.
- Flying Checkpoint: At 17:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jinata until 17:45.
- **Raid:** At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Aliyat Ali and Al-Asakra villages and summoned Anas Suleiman to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 01:35.
- **<u>Demonstration</u>**: At 10:50, a demonstration took place in Jaba' village protesting against the continued closure of the main road connecting Al-Jab'a village and Surif during which Israeli forces assaulted several demonstrators by hitting them with their rifles.

• Closure:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
- (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

• Closure of Main Roads:

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil villages.
- (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
- (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
- (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
- (v) Since July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat and closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks.

HEBRON

• Flying Checkpoint:

- (i) At 18:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ithna.
- (ii) At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Al-Fuwar junction until 21:25.
- (iii)At 20:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at Halhul Bridge until 21:40.

• Raid:

- (i) At 11:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya, stormed and searched a home then withdrew at 15:25.
- (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Bani Na'im.
- (iii) At 01:40, Israeli forces raided Dura until 04:05.
- (iv)At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Al-Thahriya until 04:05.
- (v) At 07:05, Israeli forces raided Al-Shuyoukh until 07:15

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS

- At 19:00 on August 26th 2014, Palestinian Gunmen and the Israeli military agreed to a cease fire agreement (brokered by the Arab Republic of Egypt) which includes the opening of border crossings to allow the entry of emergency supplies and humanitarian goods as well as construction material and agreed to increase the fishing limit to 6 nautical miles with possibility of increase to 12 nautical miles by the end of the year and to decrease the Military area to 100 meters, allow freedom of movement and a halt to targeted killings and assassinations and negotiations will be held for discussion on rebuilding the sea port and airports in the coming month.
- The Israeli military broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire from their positions behind the Green Line towards Central Gaza.
- Israeli Naval vessels broke the ceasefire agreement by opening fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of North Gaza.

On the morning of February 8th 2015, Israeli Naval vessels opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats off the shores of Al-Sudaniya beach in west Beit Lahiya.
GAZA	Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. (ii) Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has closed following a unilateral Israeli decision.
CENTRAL GAZA	<u>Attack:</u> On the morning of February 8 TH 2015, Israeli forces positioned behind the Green Line opened fire towards several farmers in east Al-Buriej and Al-Maghazi camps.
RAFAH	 Closure of Crossing Points: (i) Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. (ii) Rafah (Al 'Awdah) Crossing is closed. (iii) Sufa Crossing is closed. (iv) Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
