(ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Khilat Mana' area in Dura.
(iii)At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Hebron until 03:00.
• <u>Temporary Detention</u> : At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned in the old city of
Hebron temporarily detained Khalid Zahadra (10 years old) then released him at
19:40.
• <u>Wall Construction</u> : Wall construction continued in the area surrounding
the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town.

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 14th 2011 Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark and on November 24th 2012, Israeli forces imposed floating marks of 6 miles and on March 21st 2013 re imposed fishing restrictions of 3 miles. Israeli drones broke the ceasefire agreement by opening launched missiles towards Palestinian gunmen in Central Gaza and as a result critically injured a resident. Palestinian gunmen broke the cease fire agreement by launching projectiles towards the Green Line.
NORTHERN GAZA	 <u>Closure of Crossing Point</u>: Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination. <u>Palestinian Attack</u>: On the evening of February 8th 2014, Palestinian gunmen launched projectiles towards the Green Line.
GAZA	 <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision
CENTRAL GAZA	• <u>Air Strikes</u> : On the morning of February 9 th 2014, Israeli drones launched a missile towards a motor cycle carrying Abdallah Khourti; a Palestinian Gunman leaving him critically injured him and also injured another resident.
