ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.

JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrances to the Al Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. Closure of Main Roads: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al Bared in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al Bared to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area. The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. Wall Gates: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Bared, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna. Raids/Curfew/Physical Assault/Detentions: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> The Israeli army raided the village of Beit Duqqu and imposed curfew. While searching a number of houses, confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians. The Israeli army also arrested 1 civilian. The Israeli army raided the village of Qatanna, set up a checkpoint, searched civilians and vehicles, and arrested 1 civilian.

The Israeli army also detained 10 civilians.</p> <p>(iv) The Israeli army raided the town of Al 'Eizariya and arrested 2 civilians.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Arrests:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army arrested an unidentified civilian in the village of Beit Duqqu.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army arrested Isma'il Ibrahim al Faqeeh in the village of Qatanna.</p> <p>The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the town of Al 'Eizariya:</p> <p>(iii) Qasem Isma'il Dahdoul; and</p> <p>(iv) Mohammed Basem ar Reesh.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>House Demolition:</u> The Israeli army demolished 1 house in the village of Al 'Isawiya belonging to an unidentified civilian. • <u>Destruction of Property:</u> The Israeli army demolished the offices of a charitable association that serves handicapped children in Wadi al Joz neighbourhood in the city of Jerusalem, after having expelled handicapped children outside.
<p>RAMALLAH & EL BIREH</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <p>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil as well as the road to the village of Ras Karkar.</p> <p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Saffa.</p> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede civilian access. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the area west of the town of 'Abud as well as in the areas of Al Midya to Ni'lin and Ni'lin to Deir Qaddis. • <u>Raids/Detentions:</u> <p>(i) At 11:30, the Israeli army, including 4 jeeps, raided and patrolled the city of El Bireh.</p> <p>(ii) At 12:00, the Israeli army, including 14 jeeps, raided the village of 'Ein Yabrud and arrested 3 civilians, including a university student. The Israeli army also served summons to a number of civilians to report to the Israeli Intelligence agency.</p> <p>(iii) At 13:30, the Israeli army raided the village of An Nabi Salih and searched 1 house.</p> <p>(iv) At 23:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Turmus'ayya and searched 1 house, after detaining residents.</p> <p>(v) At 03:10, the Israeli army, including 10 jeeps, raided the village of Kobar, arrested 1 civilian, and withdrew at 03:50.</p> <p>(vi) At 05:10, the Israeli army, including 10 jeeps, raided the town of Beituniya and searched 1 house as well as a packing factory. The Israeli army also arrested 2 civilians and 1 Palestinian Police officer.</p>

(iv) The Israeli army arrested Zahran Ahmed al Fahel in the village of Kobar. <p>The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians and 1 Palestinian security officer in the town of Beituniya:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (v) Murad Ziyad Missfer, a Palestinian Police officer; (vi) Khaled Hussein Missfer; and (vii) Mohammed Mustafa Mis'ef.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the unpaved detour roads leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. (ii) Beginning on 29 March 2007, the Israeli army has continued to regulate times to open Al Jalama and Salim Wall gates between 06:30 until 10:00 and 17:00 until 21:00 respectively. • Flying Checkpoints: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:30, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints on the junctions to the villages of Al Kufeir and Al Jarba, searched civilians and vehicles, and impeded civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints on the junctions to the villages of Kafr Dan and Sir and searched civilians and vehicles. (iii) The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Zububa, searched civilians and vehicles, and arrested 1 civilian. • Raids/Attacks/Injury/Destruction/Confiscation of Property: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Kafr Dan. While patrolling the area, an armed confrontation took place between the Israeli army and armed Palestinian individuals. At 22:40, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. (ii) At 24:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Tammun. Confrontations took place between civilians and the Israeli army, while it was patrolling the area. (iii) At 01:00, the Israeli army, including 1 armoured vehicle and 13 jeeps, raided the town of Al Yamun and opened fire, injuring 1 civilian. The Israeli army also searched a number of houses. After destroying its doors, the Israeli army searched a cultural centre belonging to the Islamic Resistance Movement (Hamas) and confiscated 4 computers. At 02:40, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.

	<p>(iv) At 01:30, the Israeli army, including 9 jeeps and 2 bulldozers, raided the city of Jenin and Jenin refugee camp and patrolled the area until 04:00.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrest: Israeli troops positioned at the flying checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of Al Jarba arrested Kamal Mahmoud 'Ubeidi.
<p>TULKAREM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. • Closure of Main Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road, the entrance to the village of Saffarin, the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil plain, the road connecting the town of Kafr al Labad to the village of Shufa, and the road to the town of Deir al Ghusun's plain. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem) as well as at 'Einav checkpoint (the eastern entrance to the city). • Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. • Raids: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:00, the Israeli army, including 6 jeeps, raided the city of Tulkarem, searched 1 house, and withdrew at 11:50. (ii) At 02:15, the Israeli army, including 7 jeeps, raided the city of Tulkarem and Tulkarem refugee camp, searched 4 houses, and withdrew at 04:40. (iii) At 02:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of 'Izbat al Jarad. • Arrests: At 02:20 on 08 May 2007, the Israeli army arrested 5 civilians during its raids into the city of Tulkarem and Tulkarem refugee camp, in addition to those reported yesterday: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Nassr Samarah; (ii) Ahmed Matrouk; (iii) Nidhal Abu Thareefeh; (iv) Ahmed Abu Salah; and (v) 'Issam Jeetawi.
<p>QALQILIYA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Roads: The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. • Wall Construction: Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the southern entrance to the city of Qalqiliya and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the northern entrance to the town of 'Azzun and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids/House Occupation/Attack/Injury:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 22:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Kafr Laqif, occupied 1 house under construction, converted it into a military post, and withdrew at a later time. (ii) At 22:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Qalqiliya. Confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians, during which the Israeli army injured 1 civilian. At 03:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. • <u>Palestinian Security Measure:</u> At 15:00, Palestinian security forces handed over 1 illegal vehicle, seized in the city of Qalqiliya, to the Israeli authorities (through the DCO).
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Huwwara and Beit Iba checkpoints (set up at the southern and western entrances to the city of Nablus respectively) are closed at 23:00. The Israeli army only allows civilian vehicles possessing access permits to cross these checkpoints. The Israeli army also searches civilians using metal detectors at Beit Iba checkpoint, impeding their access. (ii) At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jirzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighbourhood only. (iii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the village of Beit Dajan until 17:30. (iv) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira ash Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases. • <u>Raids/Curfew/Detentions/Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 08:50, the Israeli army raided the town of Huwwara and imposed curfew, allegedly for throwing stones. At 10:00, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. (ii) At 15:45, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided and patrolled the village of Sabastiya. (iii) At 23:00, the Israeli army raided the village of 'Iraq at Tayyah and detained 3 children.

	<p>(iv) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus and Balata refugee camp. While patrolling the refugee camp, the Israeli army opened fire. At 04:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area.</p> <p>(v) The Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Sabastiya.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Arrest: At 12:30, Israeli troops positioned at Beit Iba checkpoint arrested 'Imad Abdul Ghani al Aswad. • Destruction of Property: At 01:40 on 08 May 2007, the Israeli army destroyed (using explosives) a blacksmith's workshop belonging to As'ad Nassrallah during its raid into the city of Nablus.
SALFIT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army has continued to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and, with cement blocks, the western entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik. • Checkpoints: (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut checkpoint and to deny civilian access to the town of Kafr ad Dik. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the Za'tara junction checkpoint and to impede civilian access. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el. • Raids/Attacks: (i) At 20:45, the Israeli army raided the town of Deir Ballut and opened indiscriminate fire, while patrolling the area. At 21:15, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. (ii) The Israeli army raided the village of Yasuf. While patrolling the area, confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians.
JERICHO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. • Checkpoints: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at Al Hamra checkpoint set up along Al Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of Al 'Auja along Al Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah.
BETHLEHEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. • Closure of Main Roads: (i) The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60.

	<p>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the detour roads leading to the town of Tuqu'.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of Al Khadr, northwest of the city of Beit Jala, and in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Efrat. • Raids/Destruction of Property: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 09:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Za'tara and the village of Dar Salah. (ii) At 03:00, the Israeli army raided the city of Beit Jala and the town of Al Khadr, searched 1 building, and patrolled the area. (iii) At 06:30, the Israeli army raided the village of Al Walaja and demolished a sheep pen, claiming that it was built without the required construction licence. • Air Patrols: At 15:00, Israeli combat helicopters patrolled the skies over towns and villages in the eastern Bethlehem district. In addition, Israeli reconnaissance aircraft patrolled the skies over the city of Bethlehem.
<p style="text-align: center;">HEBRON</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of Al Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access to and from the area. (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of As Samoa'; the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of Al Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to Al 'Arrub refugee camp. (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street

	<p>that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of Ar Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta. • Raids/Destruction of Property/Detention: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 23:45, the Israeli army, including 1 armoured vehicle and 8 jeeps, raided the city of Hebron and searched a number of houses as well as 1 commercial shop. (ii) At 00:25, the Israeli army raided the town of Taffuh, destroyed the door of a house, detained 1 civilian, and released him at a later time. (iii) At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Ula, searched a number of houses, and arrested 1 civilian. (iv) At 03:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Halhul. • Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Mu'ayyad Mohammed as Sarahin in the town of Beit Ula.

However, the Israeli army opened fire towards Palestinian territory on 3 occasions. The Israeli army also carried out 3 raids into Palestinian territory. In addition, Israeli navy boats arrested a fisherman and detained 3 others. Moreover, armed Palestinian individuals fired 3 mortars towards the Green Line.
<p style="text-align: center;">NORTHERN GAZA</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open to foreign nationals, humanitarian cases, and VIPs. • Raids: In violation of the Israeli-Palestinian ceasefire agreement, the Israeli army carried out 3 raids into Palestinian territory, as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:50, the Israeli army, including 1 armoured vehicle and 2 bulldozers, raided Palestinian territory near Point 15 on the Green Line north of the town of Beit Lahiya. (ii) At 12:30, the Israeli army, including 1 armoured vehicle and 2 bulldozers, raided 500 metres into Palestinian territory near Point 64 on the Green Line east of the town of Jabalya. (iii) At 21:30, Israeli army infantry forces raided Palestinian territory near Point 15 on the Green Line north of the town of Beit Lahiya. Israeli army infantry forces remain positioned in the area as of 08:00 this morning. • Palestinian Attack: At 16:00, armed Palestinian individuals fired 1 unidentified mortar towards the Green Line, thereby violating the Israeli-Palestinian ceasefire agreement.

(ii) At 15:20, the Israeli army opened fire from the area near Point 83 on the Green Line towards a number of farmers east of Gaza city.

(iv) Karm Abu Slim (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed. • Attack: At 01:30, the Israeli army opened fire from the area near Point 207 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory east of the city of Rafah, thereby violating the Israeli-Palestinian ceasefire agreement. • Arrest/Detentions: At 08:10, Israeli navy boats arrested Jamil an Nada, a fishermen, at sea as well detained 3 others. • Palestinian Attack: At 06:00, armed Palestinian individuals fired 2 unidentified mortars towards the Green Line, thereby violating the Israeli-Palestinian ceasefire agreement. • Palestinian Security Measure: At 10:40, Palestinian security forces sealed off and demolished a tunnel, located on the Egyptian border in Rafah refugee camp.
