JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) On January 9th 2016, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint. (iii) On November 16th 2015, Israeli forces closed the south entrance of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood in Jerusalem, which leads to “Armon Hantsiv” settlement with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city. (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Anata then searched residents and vehicles. • <u>Raid:</u> On the evening of January 9th 2016, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village, clashed with several residents and temporarily detained the child: Majd Aziz Obied (8 years old) then released him later from a Police station near Salah Al-Din road in the old city of Jerusalem. • <u>Attack:</u> At 22:30, Israeli forces positioned at Shu’fat checkpoint fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> At 10:00, Israeli forces detained two residents: Mu’tasim Al-Masri and Mohammad Shawamra (both residents of Shu’fat camp). • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.

On October 3rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near “Bet El” settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. (iii) Since November 24th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance of Sinjil and the east entrance of Al-Mughier village with cement blocks.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iv) At 18:50 on December 4th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main entrance of Abboud with cement blocks. (v) On December 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed the West entrance of Al-Labban Al-Gharbi village with cement blocks. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:40 and again at 19:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atarah bridge located in North Bir Ziet then searched residents and vehicles until 21:30. (ii) At 12:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Al-Nabi Saleh village then searched residents and vehicles until 15:40. (iii) At 12:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Deir Dibwan and Burqa village then searched residents and vehicles until 15:30. (iv) At 12:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Ur Al-Foqa then searched residents and vehicles until 17:25. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya’bad. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint in the area between Beit Qad and Jalboun villages then searched residents and vehicles until 22:00. • <u>Raid:</u> At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Yamoun. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 17:45, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at “Eniv” checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic until 19:10. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 21:05, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Kafriyat road located in south Tulkarem and detained three residents after assaulting them. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained three residents: Ibrahim Sami Abdel-Rahim Al-Akhras, Mohammad Sami Abdel Rahim Al-Khras and Yamin Jihad Mohammad Jizmawi.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town. (ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village. (iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far’ata village which is located near “Gillad” settlement with dirt mounds

	<p>(iv) Since 10:40 on September 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 20:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ras Attiya village then searched residents and vehicles. (ii) At 00:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the east entrance of Qalqiliya then searched residents and vehicles until 01:10. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Jayyous fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Demonstration:</u> At 15:30, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces tried to disrupt the demonstration by firing live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators who attempted to reach their demonstration site and as a result injured Maher Mahmoud Mohamad Suliman (60 years old).. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya, the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
<p>NABLUS</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> Since December 17th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik-Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and Qaryut. (iii) At 06:30 on November 22nd 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Aqraba and Yanoun village with dirt mounds. (iv) On November 29th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Burin, Awarta and Osirin as well as the agricultural bypass road connecting Aqraba and Qabalan village with dirt mounds. (v) At 13:00 on December 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Tel village and the bypass road near "Yitsahar" settlement and installed a steel gate in the area. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> At 10:35, Israeli forces closed Huwarah checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic until 17:25. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 14:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Deir Sharaf village junction then searched residents and vehicles until 16:00. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 14:00, Israeli forces raided Qusra village , stormed a chicken farm after breaking open the main gate entrance then proceeded to dismantle several Mobile trailers which were fixed at an earlier time (ii) At 01:00, Israeli forces raided Sarah village stormed and searched two homes and summoned Shawqi Jamil Abu Tarabi to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 01:55.

(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the North entrance of Salfit then searched residents and vehicles until 14:50. (ii) At 15:55, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Deir Istiya then searched residents and vehicles. • <u>Raid:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 00:20, Israeli forces raided Yasuf village until 00:50. (iii) At 01:50, Israeli forces raided Salfit, clashed with several residents then withdrew at 01:35. • <u>Detention:</u> At 23:50, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Deir Ballout detained the child: Mohammad Omar Ibrahim Abdallah (17 years old) {A resident of Deir Ballout}.
<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 08:40, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the Dead Sea junction then searched residents and vehicles.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. (ii) Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Beit Jala-Wadi Ahmed road; a road between Um Tuba and Al-Jass ; a road between Um Tuba and Khilat Nu'man: a road between Um Tuba and the wall; a road between Al-Khas village and the wall; the 2 by pass roads located south of Al-Walaja; a road between Talita Qumi and Nazlat Al-Sider in Beit Jala; the eastern road of Al-Khader; the road between Al-Khader and Beit Jala ; Wadi Rahal road near "Ifrat" settlement ,the road between Al-Khader and road #60 which lead to the eastern neighbourhoods of Bethlehem; a road leading to Wadi Rahal, and a road east of Beit Fajjar town with dirt mounds. (iii) At 02:20, Israeli forces raided Husan village. • <u>Attack:</u> At 16:10, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Ayda camp in North Bethlehem fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. • <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Ahmad Mahmoud Najajrah and Nassar Aqel Najajrah.

HEBRON

- **Closure:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close Khuzq Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
 - (ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
 - (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Karmil villages.
 - (ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
 - (iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
 - (iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to e to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
 - (v) At 05:50 on November 5th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance leading Farsh Al-Hawa area in Hebron with Cement blocks.
 - (vi) At 10:30 on November 8th 2015, Israeli forces closed the junction located near "Hagi" settlement located in south Hebron with cement blocks.
 - (vii) At 21:00 on November 11th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road connecting Beit Awwa and Al-Majd village with cement block and dirt mounds.
 - (viii) At 15:45 on November 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed Al-Samiya village junction located at the west entrance of Al-Samou' with cement blocks.
 - (ix) On November 15th 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Khliat Al-Miya and Al Dirat and the two bypass roads leading east Yatta with cement blocks.
 - (x) On November 23rd 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Qom village located in North Beit Awwa with Cement blocks.
 - (xi) On December 1st 2015, Israeli forces closed a checkpoint located along Al-Shuhada road located in the old city of Hebron and prevented residents from passing through the checkpoint and redirected traffic through a road near the entrance of Jabal Al-Rahma.
 - (xii) On December 9th 2015, Israeli forces closed a road near Jabal Jallis area located in the old city of Hebron and closed the bypass road.
 - (xiii) At 01:45 on January 8th 2016, Israeli forces closed the entrances of Sair and Al-Shiyoukh towns and prevented residents from entering or exiting the area with the exception of emergency health cases.
