SALFIT	 <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland. On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from 08:00 until 09:20. Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and QatanAl-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. <u>Raid:</u> (i) At 12:00, Israeli forces raided Kafr Al-Dik, set up a checkpoint, temporarily detained Ziyad Ali (A Police Officer) and Moath Ahmad then withdrew at 14:00. (ii) At 01:20, Israeli forces raided Deir Istiya, stormed a home, summoned Mu'taz Salim to report to Israeli intelligence for questioning then withdrew at 02:10. <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction resumed in the area north of Deir Istiya town southeast of the illegal settlement.
JERICHO	 <u>Checkpoints:</u> Israeli forces continues to intensify its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus Districts and imped the free flow of traffic. <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> (i) At 15:50, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint along Al-Taybeh junction along the road connecting Ramallah and Jericho. (ii) At 19:15, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Jiftlik village. <u>Raid:</u> At 19:20, Israeli forces raided Al-Jiftlik village and conducted military exercises. <u>Detention:</u> On December 9th 2012, Israeli forces positioned at Allenby bridge crossing detained Mohammad Khderat, a residents of Hebron.
BETHLEHEM	 <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the

	(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them access to the area.

	(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.

GAZA STRIP

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 24th 2012, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark. Israeli forces broke the cease fire agreement by opening fire towards Khan Yunis.

NORTHERN GAZA	• <u>Closure of Crossing Point</u> : Beit Hanun (Erez) is open for the passage of critical patients, journalists, NGO staff, businessmen and passengers travelling abroad through Al-Karama crossing with previous coordination.
GAZA	 <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. <u>Aerial Surveillance:</u> On the evening of December 9th 2012, Israeli F-16 fighter jets surveyed the skies of Gaza. <u>Killing:</u> On December 9th 2012, Nasser Al-Najal, Palestinian gunmen died injuries sustained from Israeli airstrikes towards the Gaza strip last month.
KHAN YUNIS	• <u>Raid:</u> On the morning of December 10 th 2012, Israeli forces escorting several military bulldozers stormed and raided 100 meters into the vicinity of Al-Fakhary village and levelled plots of land near the border fence.
RAFAH	 <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the exit of patients, students, passengers with permits and International aid. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is. Open for the entry of humanitarian supplies, cooking gas, 5 truckloads of wheat and Livestock feed and construction material for internationally funded projects and exported several tons of Cherry tomatoes.
