JERUSALEM	<ul> <li><u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem and set up several checkpoints in the old city of Jerusalem and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound.</li> <li><u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Qalandiya checkpoint and to impede civilian access.</li> <li><u>Wall Gates</u>: The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks.</li> <li><u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, and in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina.</li> <li><u>Flving Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to 'Atarot Industrial Zone and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li><u>Raid</u>: The Israeli army raided the village of Al 'Isawiya northeast of the city of Jerusalem and demolished 1 house under construction.</li> <li><u>House Demolition</u>: The Israeli army demolished 1 house belonging to Ala' ad Din Mustafa Taha in the village of Al 'Isawiya.</li> </ul>
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	<ul> <li><u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, and in the town of Beituniya.</li> <li><u>Flying Checkpoint</u>: At 08:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint between the villages of An Nabi Salih and Kafr 'Ein and searched civilians and vehicles until 11:30.</li> <li><u>Raids</u>: <ul> <li>(i) At 22:20, the Israeli army, including 4 jeeps, raided the city of Ramallah, patrolled the area, and withdrew at 01:30.</li> <li>(ii) At 06:30, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided and patrolled the village of Kafr 'Ein.</li> <li>(iii) At 06:30, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the town of Beit Rima, set up a checkpoint, and searched civilians and vehicles. The Israeli army remains positioned in the town as of 08:00 this morning.</li> </ul> </li> <li><u>Arrest</u>: At 11:00 on 12 September 2005, Israeli troops positioned at the checkpoint set up in the area between the town of Silwad and the village of Yabrud arrested Wael Ahmed Khader, a Palestinian General Intelligence officer.</li> </ul>

	<u>Closure of Settlement Evacuation Areas</u> :
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Israeli
	settlements that were evacuated in the district of Jenin, instead
	designating alternate roads, including detour routes, connecting towns
	and villages to the city of Jenin for civilian access.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the main entrance to the town of
	'Arraba with cement blocks.
	(iii) The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate set up in the vicinity of
	the village of Imreiha south of the town of Ya'bad, along the road
	connecting the districts of Jenin and Tulkarem, and to deny civilian
	access in both directions.
	(iv) The Israeli army continues to close Al Jalama Commercial Crossing,
	preventing civilians from crossing. Alternatively, the Israeli army has
	opened Salim Crossing 3 days a week from 09:00 until 13:00.
	(v) The Israeli army continues to restrict civilian movement (except for
	humanitarian cases) through Um ar Rihan (Shaked) gate to 3 hours
	daily from 07:00-08:00, 12:00-13:00, and 14:00-15:00.

	Dotan military post, even though he possesses a press card.

	towards the Israeli army positioned in the evacuated settlement of Kadim.
	The Israeli army responded by opening fire towards the eastern quarter of
	the city of Jenin.

	<u>Closure of Main Roads/Land Levelling:</u>
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the iron gate set up on the junction
	to the settlement of 'Einav along the Tulkarem-Nablus road, preventing
	civilians from crossing in both directions.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the main entrance to the village of
	Shufa with cement blocks and dirt barricades.
	(iii) The Israeli army continues to close Al Kafriyat road at Jubara
	checkpoint, rerouting Palestinian civilian traffic to a new 3-km-long
	road, including a tunnel, connecting the districts of Qalqiliya and
	Tulkarem.
	(iv) At 17:30, the Israeli army closed the road connecting the town of Bal'a
	and the village of Al 'Atara with dirt barricades. The Israeli army also
	levelled some portions of the road, denying access to civilians.

	the northern entrance to the town of 'Azzun and searched civilians and
	vehicles until 00:50.

	• <u>Palestinian Security Measure</u> : At 14:00, Palestinian security forces handed over 1 illegal vehicle, seized in the city of Qalqiliya, to the Israeli authorities (through the DCO).
NABLUS	<ul> <li>Closure of Main Roads: <ul> <li>The Israeli army continues to close the main road leading to the district of Jenin between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira ash Shamaliya.</li> <li>Checkpoint: At 18:00, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Beit Furik checkpoint; At 13:10, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the villages of Till and Sarra and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>Raids/Detention:</li> <li>At 21:10, the Israeli army raided the area of Al Quds Street at the southern entrance to the city of Nablus and searched 1 commercial shop, after detaining civilians inside. SALFIT	<ul> <li><u>Closure of Main Road</u>: The Israeli army continues to close the main northwestern entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades. The road has been closed since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising).</li> <li><u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to close Deir Ballut checkpoint overnight and open it at various times in the morning, impeding civilian movement.</li> <li><u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues near the Green Line in the town of Deir Ballut and the villages of Az Zawiya and Rafat, northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the villages of Marda and Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el.</li> <li><u>Raid/Detention</u>: At 21:30, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the village of Rafat, patrolled the area, and detained 2 children for several hours.</li> <li><u>Arrest</u>: The Israeli army arrested Abdul Lateef Salah Abdul Fattah near the settlement of Ari'el.</li> </ul>

JERICHO	<ul> <li><u>Closure</u>: The road between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja (Road # 90) is closed with cement blocks. The Israeli army continues to prevent farmers not holding Jericho ID cards from reaching their agricultural land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also sporadically impedes civilian movement into the city of Jericho, except for holders of Jerusalem and Jericho ID cards.</li> <li><u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Al Hamra checkpoint, connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus, and to impede civilian access.</li> <li><u>Flving Checkpoints/Air Patrol</u>: <ul> <li>(i) At 09:00, the Israeli army set up several flying checkpoints along the road connecting the district of Jericho to the area of Al Khan al Ahmar leading to the city of Jerusalem and searched civilians and vehicles. An Israeli army helicopter also patrolled the skies over the area.</li> <li>(ii) At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint along Road # 90 in the centre of the village of Al 'Auja and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
BETHLEHEM	<ul> <li><u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to close the road to the village of An Nu'man, in the north-eastern Bethlehem district, isolating the village. The Israeli army considers civilians' residence in the village illegal.</li> <li><u>Checkpoint</u>: At 14:30, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the 'Container') checkpoint and impeded civilian access.</li> <li><u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues north of 'Ayda refugee camp towards the area north of the city of Beit Jala.</li> <li><u>Flving Checkpoint</u>: At 14:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the city of Beit Sahur and searched civilians and vehicles until 15:25.</li> <li><u>Physical Assault</u>: Israeli troops positioned at As Sawahira ash Sharqiya (the 'Container') checkpoint severely beat Ahmed Jalal Sanad. At 16:00, Sanad was admitted to Al Hussein Hospital in the city of Bethlehem for treatment of injuries sustained.</li> <li><u>Raids</u>: <ul> <li>(i) At 10:40, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Al 'Ubeidiya and the village of Dar Salah and withdrew at 12:45.</li> <li>(ii) At 11:05, the Israeli army infantry forces raided and patrolled the city of Bethlehem and 'Ayda refugee camp.</li> <li>(iv) At 01:00, the Israeli army, including 6 jeeps, raided the town of Al 'Ubeidiya, set up a checkpoint along the main road in the town's centre, and searched civilians and vehicles.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

HEBRON	<ul> <li>Closure: <ul> <li>The Israeli army continues to close Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh in the H2 section of the city of Hebron with cement blocks and barbed wire, denying access to civilians and vehicles.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to close Ash Shallala old and new streets in the H1 section of the city of Hebron with cement blocks located 300 meters inside the H1 section.</li> <li>The Israeli army continues to close the old gold market in the old city of Hebron with an iron gate.</li> <li>Wall Construction: Wall construction continues west of the town of Surif to Beit Ula, in the town of Idna, from the village of Deir Samit to the village of Beit 'Awwa, from Beit 'Awwa to the village of Al Burj, and south of the towns of Adh Dhahiriya and As Samoa'.</li> <li>Flving Checkpoints/Detentions:</li> <li>At 10:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the towns of Surif and Kharas and searched civilians and vehicles. • Killing: The Israeli army killed Walid Suleiman al Khamayseh in the
village of Taffuh.
• House Occupation: At 09:00, the Israeli army occupied 1 house belonging
to Sameeh Abu 'Eisheh in the neighbourhood of Tall Rumeida in the old
city of Hebron and converted it into a military post, after forcing civilians to
evacuate. At 10:00, the Israeli army withdrew from the house.

A Palestinian engineering unit defused the shell.</li> </ul>
