JERUSALEM	 <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem and has set up several checkpoints in the old city of Jerusalem and around Al Aqsa Mosque compound. <u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Qalandiya checkpoint and to impede civilian access. <u>Wall Gates</u>: The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, and in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	 Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in the areas of Al Midya to Budrus, Al Midya to Ni'lin, Bil'in to Saffa, in the village of Beit Liqya, and in the town of Beituniya. Flving Checkpoints: At 16:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the Ramallah-Bir Zeit road, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian access. At 19:30, the Israeli army set up 2 flying checkpoints on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and on the junction to the settlement of Halamish, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian access. At 20:40, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the villages of An Nabi Salih and Kafr 'Ein and searched civilians and vehicles until 02:00. Raids/Curfew: At 02:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the village of Kafr 'Ein. At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Beituniya, searched 1 building, and arrested 2 civilians, including 1 university student. At 03:25, the Israeli army raided the village of Qarawat Bani Zeid, imposed curfew, searched a number of houses. Arrests: At 22:40 on 15 October 2005, the Israeli army arrested Mohammed Mousa al Hajj in the village of Beit Sira.

Wall Gates: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. Flying Checkpoints: (i) At 24:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Jubara tunnel road and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area between the town of Kafr al Labad and the village of Al Hafasa and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) Raid/Detention: At 02:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Qaffin, searched a number of houses, arrested 4 civilians, and detained 2 others. At 04:50, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. Arrests: The Israeli army arrested 4 civilians in the town of Qaffin: (i) Amin Ahmed Tu'meh; (ii) Mohammed Mustafa I'mariyyeh; (iii) 'Abed Ya'qoub Kittaneh; and (iv) Nassri Sadeq Abu Bakr. Palestinian Attack: At 01:30, armed Palestinian individuals opened fire towards Israeli troops positioned at the DCO offices west of the city of Tulkarem.
QALQILIYA	 <u>Wall Gates</u>: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. <u>Wall Construction</u>: Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the village of Immatin and in the area east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun. <u>Flying Checkpoints</u>: At 18:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Jinsafut leading to Wadi Qana road and searched civilians and vehicles. (i) At 20:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the eastern entrance to the city of Qalqiliya, searched civilian vehicles, and impeded civilian movement.

NABLUS	 <u>Closure of Main Roads</u>: The Israeli army continues to close the main road leading to the district of Jenin between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting the city of Nablus and the town of 'Asira ash Shamaliya. <u>Raids/Destruction of Property</u>: Beginning at 07:35 on 16 October 2005, the Israeli army remained positioned in the village of Kafr Qalil and arrested 2 civilians, in addition to those reported yesterday. At 10:45, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. At 00:20, the Israeli army raided the village of Deir al Hatab and searched 1 house, damaging furniture. At 03:00, the Israeli army raided Balata refugee camp, searched 1 house, and withdrew at 05:00. <u>Arrests</u>: The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the village of Kafr Qalil: 'Assem Walid 'Amer; and Iyad Davoud 'Amer. At 18:30, Israeli torops positioned at Beit Iba checkpoint west of the city of Nablus arrested Dr. Khader Abdul Ra'ouf Sondak, Dean of the Islamic Studies Faculty at An Najah University and a candidate running for the upcoming Palestinian Legislative elections. <u>Settler Violence</u> At 18:20, a group of Israeli settlers set fire to forest trees in the vicinity of the village of Salim. At 07:30, a group of Israeli settlers threw stones at civilians and prevented them from crossing the checkpoint set up at the entrance to the town of Beit Furik. <u>Palestinian Attack</u>: At 18:30, armed Palestinian individuals opened fire towards a number of Israeli settlers near the settlement of 'Eli in the vicinity of the village of Al Lubban ash Sharqi.
SALFIT	 <u>Closure of Main Roads</u>: The Israeli army continues to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades. The road has been closed since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) At 22:20, the Israeli army closed the Trans-Samaria Highway, denying access to civilians until further notice. <u>Checkpoints</u>: The Israeli army continues to close Deir Ballut checkpoint overnight and open it at various times in the morning, impeding civilian movement. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of Qarawat Bani Hassan with an iron gate.

	 Israeli army released the detained civilians. (ii) At 19:35, an Israeli army patrol raided the villages of 'Ammuriya and Khirbet Qeis, set up a checkpoint at the southern entrance to the city of 		
	 Salfit, searched civilians and vehicles, and withdrew at 01:40. (iii) At 19:40, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the town of Deir Istiya, searched 1 house, and withdrew at 23:00. 		
JERICHO	 <u>Closure</u>: The road between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja (Road # 90) is closed with cement blocks. The Israeli army continues to prevent farmers not holding Jericho ID cards from reaching their agricultural land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also sporadically impedes civilian movement into the city of Jericho, except for holders of Jerusalem and Jericho ID cards. <u>Checkpoints/Detention</u>: (i) At 19:30, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Al Hamra checkpoint on the road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus. The Israeli army also detained dozens of civilians, including those travelling to Saudi Arabia to perform <i>Al 'Umrah</i> ("minor pilgrimage") in Mecca. (ii) At 11:10, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at the DCO checkpoint set up at the southern entrance to the city of Jericho and impeded civilian access in both directions. Flying Checkpoint: At 18:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Al Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah and searched civilians and vehicles. 		
BETHLEHEM	• <u>Closure</u> : The Israeli army continues to close the road to the village of An Nu'man in the north-eastern Bethlehem district, isolating the village. The Israeli army considers the civilians' residence in the village illegal.		

	 Closure of Main Roads: At 16:40, the Israeli army closed Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, denying access to civilians. Raids: At 20:25, the Israeli army, including several jeeps and 1 bulldozer, raided the town of Al Khadr, placed cement blocks, and erected dirt barricades on Al Madares junction in the town. At 21:15, Israeli army infantry forces raided 'Ayda refugee camp, fired sonic bombs and flares while patrolling the area, and withdrew at 22:15.
