Assault on Medical Sector	2	—	2	Israeli forces temporarily seized an Ambulance near the entrance of Beit Furiq while its was carrying a corpse of a residents killed and proceeded to take photographs of the corpse and opened fire towards an ambulance near Huwara checkpoint in Nablus as it was carrying an injured residents.
Settler Violence	10	—	10	Israeli settlers assaulted several residents, stoned residents, vehicles and homes, chopped off tree limbs, assaulted several residents while they were harvesting Olives in Jerusalem, Ramallah, Tulkarem, Nablus, Salfit, Bethlehem and Hebron.
Demonstration	3	—	3	Against the construction of the wall, settlement construction, the closure of roads.

<b>JERUSALEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On October 16<sup>th</sup> 2015, the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshipers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound, which forced residents to conduct prayers near checkpoints located outside Al-Aqsa mosque compound.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> <li>(iii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road leading to Al-Eisawiya village with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iv) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the four entrances of Jabal Al-Mukabir neighbourhood with cement blocks.</li> <li>(v) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the three entrances of Sur Bahar with Cement blocks.</li> <li>(vi) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Al-Tur neighbourhood (leading to Al-Za’im village in Jericho and Al-Eizariya) and Suliman French road with cement blocks.</li> <li>(vii) On October 14<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the entrance of Wadi Al-Rabaybeh area in Silwan neighbourhood in Jerusalem with cement blocks.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>(ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 02:15, Israeli forces raided Anata and clashed with several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 12:20, Israeli forces positioned in Ras Al-Amoud neighbourhood fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(ii) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned near Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iii) At 14:55, Israeli forces positioned near Shu’fat checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iv) At 15:10, Israeli forces positioned near the North junction of Al-Ram fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(v) At 16:10, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Ras Kabsa area near Al-Eizariya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(vi) At 16:30, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jabal junction in Abu Dis fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 04:15 on October 16<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained 3 residents: Majdi Fawzi Salah, Islam Ahmad Khalaf Jamous and Imad Rabi’ Rabi’ during their raid into Abu Dis in addition to those mentioned in the previous report.</li> <li>(ii) At dawn on October 16<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces detained six residents including four children: Hussien Bassam Khaweis (17 years old), Mohmamd Najji Abu Jum’a (16 years old), Mahdi Ahmad Sabri Al-Sayad (17 years old), Hisham Ahmad Abu Al-Hawa (16 years old) and Hadi Sufiyab Abu Al-Hawa in Al-Tur neighbourhood.</li> <li>(iii) At 10:30, Israeli forces detained Shadi Muhsien (A resident of Al-Eisawiya).</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Home Confiscation:</u></b> On October 15<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli military courts ruled in favor of Israeli settlers to confiscate a Palestinian home owned by Ghayth Sab Al-Labans family in the old city Jerusalem and gave the owners 45 days to remove their belongings from inside the home.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 15:00, Israeli settlers stormed Shu’fat neighbourhood and damaged a vehicle owned by Abu Khalaf family.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Slewahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p><b>RAMALLAH &amp; AL BIREH</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Sinjil village well as the junction to Kafr Malik and ‘Ein Samiya villages</li> <li>(ii) . On October 3<sup>rd</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road located near “Bet El” settlement and leading to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks.</li> <li>(iii) Since 18:40 on October 16<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed the road between Silwad and Deir Jreir village located near “Ofra” settlement and closed the road connecting Silwad and Ain Yabrod with dirt mounds.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b></li> </ul>

- (i) At 08:45, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near the entrance of Um Safa village.
- (ii) At 21:20, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Ni'lin until 22:50.
- (iii) On the evening of October 16<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli force set up a checkpoint near Eiyoun Al-Haramiya area and detained two children.

- **Raid:** At 17:55, Israeli forces raided Silwad {for the alleged shooting towards a military watch tower located along a bypass road between Silwad and Yabrud village) during which they clashed with several residents and as a result injured Mohammad Awad Hamad and detained a resident as well as temporarily detaining Nour Nidal Ayad then released him at a later time.

- **Detention:**

- (i) Israeli Arrested Muhammed Humida 17 years old, and Sultan Hujaz 17 years near Eiyoun Al-Haramiya area (both were from El Mazra; an El Sharqeh).
- (ii) Israeli Forces arrested Muhammad Ayad from Silwad.

- **Attack:**

- (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces positioned in the vicinity Al-Mahakma checkpoint located near "Bet El" settlement in North Al-Bireh city fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents (who were protesting against the continued Israeli Military and Settler assault on Al-Aqsa mosque compound )for alleged stoning and as a result injured 21 residents including 2 children and a journalist: Adham Mahmoud Mubarak (16 years old), Muslalam Yusef Ghawanma (15 years old), Mohammad Al-Ori (A journalist), Mohammad Saud Assi, Ashraf Ibrahim Hashayka, Mohammad Ahmad Assad Lolo, Atef Thaher Abu Qubtiya, Ahmad Mohammad Abdallah, Mohammad Mahmoud Orat, Hadi Ismail Hussien, Rashed Imad Ibrahim, Asma Mahmoud Al-Ramahi, Sa'dallah Ibrahim Saleh, , Awad Mohammad Ali, Ali Adel Showiki, Ahmad Nafiz Abdel-Al, Ahmad Abdel-Kareem Al-Dadawat, Wael Ramadan Al-Ajouli, , Awni Mohammad Alwa, Ihab Mohammad Assi, and Mahmoud Yusef Ghanam and left several others suffocating due to inhaling tear gas.
- (ii) At 13:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iii) At 14:15, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Sinjil fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (iv) At 14:40, Israeli forces positioned near Beit Liqya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (v) At 14:50, Israeli forces positioned near Budrus village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (vi) At 15:50, Israeli forces positioned near Deir Nathim village fired live ammunition; rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (vii) At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Deir Qudies village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (viii) At 18:50, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Janiya village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
- (ix) At 19:15, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Shuqba village fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 12:20, Israeli settlers stoned residents and vehicle in the area located between Deir Nathim and Beit Illo villages then withdrew under the protection of Israeli force at 13:05.</li> <li>(ii) At 14:30, Israeli settlers positioned near Al-Mazra'a Al-Gharbiya village opened fire towards Ghassan Hassan Nimer Ramadan (A resident of Al-Mazra'a Al-Gharbiya village) as he was collecting Olive harvest and told him to leave the area.</li> <li>(iii) At 15:00, Israeli settlers stormed Wadi Al-Inab area located between Ras Kar Kar and Deir Ibzi' then terrorized and provoked residents.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Demonstrations:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 13:35, a demonstration took place in Ni'lin protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result injured Issah Muhieb Sarour and left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>(ii) At 1400, a demonstration took place in Bil'in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result and left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<p><b>JENIN</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Road:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan.</li> <li>(ii) Since the evening of November 25<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> At 14:30, Israeli forces positioned near the entrance of Al-Jamalah checkpoint located in North Jenin fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured 2 residents including a child: Mustafa Ahmad Shibani (16 years old) and Wael Suliman Al-Sha'er as well as leaving Alla Al-Din Al-Labadi suffocated from tear gas inhalation and also temporarily detained 3 residents including a child: Ahmad Ziyad Hardan (17 years old), Ahmad Hussien Mohammad and Majd Hamdan then released them at a later time.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> Israeli forces continue to close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.</li> </ul>
<p><b>TULKAREM</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoint:</u></b> Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint located along the main road connecting Tulkarem and Nablus and impeded the free flow of traffic.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> At 19:45, Israeli forces raided Zietta until 19:55.</li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> At 13:10, Israeli forces positioned near (Ghishouri) industrial zone located in west Tulkarem fired live ammunition, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured two residents: Waleed Adel Abu Safqa and Ahmad Mustafa Abu Hamdiya as well as leaving Omar Mustafa Abu Daya suffocating from tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>• <b><u>Settler Violence:</u></b> At 08:55, a group of Israeli settlers stormed agricultural land near "Eniv" settlement and assaulted several residents and farmers as they were collecting Olive harvest and forced them to leave the area at 09:10.</li> </ul>
<p><b>QALQILIYA</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.</li> <li>(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.</li> <li>(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18<sup>th</sup> 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with dirt mounds</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

	<p>(iv) Since 10:40 on September 1<sup>st</sup> 2015, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement with a steel Gate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Flying Checkpoint:</u></b> At 21:00, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Izbit Al-Tabib village until 23:00.</li> <li>• <b><u>Raid:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 03:00 on October 16<sup>th</sup> 2015, Israeli forces raided Hajja village and detained 4 residents.</li> <li>(ii) At 22:00, Israeli forces raided Izbit Al-Tabib village, stormed a wedding and temporarily detained several residents then released them after inspecting their identification cards and then withdrew at 00:30,</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Attack:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) At 13:45, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Azzun, fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured the child: Layth Eyad Radwan (13 years old) and detained a child after assaulting him and also damaged a vehicle owned by Nidal Ahmad Hussien.</li> <li>(ii) At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate near Al-Naqqar neighbourhood in Qalqiliya fired stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result, left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>(iii) At 15:35 and again at 21:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Jaljoliya gate located in south west Qalqiliya fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.</li> <li>(iv) At 15:40, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate near Tabal area in Qalqeleh fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result, Maha Qudeh was suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>(v) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in south Qalqiliya fired, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning and as a result injured three residents: Haytham Yusef Hassanin, Abdallah Khaled Hutouri and Hussien Mohammad Al-Shanto as well as leaving three others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Detention:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) Israeli forces detained four residents: Mahmoud Nabil Basalat, Muhanad Fakr Basalat and Mohammad Khaled Basalat in Hajja village.</li> <li>(ii) Israeli forces detained Zied Ali Abdel-Hafith Adwan (17 years old) near the entrance of Azzoun.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Demonstration:</u></b> At 13:40, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces who raided the village, occupied the rooftops of several homes and converted them into military posts and tried to disrupt the demonstration by firing live ammunition, rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators who attempted to reach they demonstration site and as a result left several others suffocated from tear gas inhalation.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to deny civilian access.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> Since December 17<sup>th</sup> 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500 dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.</li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b></li> </ul>
