ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints set up on the main roads connecting the West Bank districts, thereby isolating the northern districts from the southern districts as well as the Jericho district and the Jordan Valley from the remainder of the West Bank.
JERUSALEM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrances to Al Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and impede civilian access to the mosque. • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat al Bared in the city of Jerusalem with a barbed wire gate and to deny civilian access. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the road connecting Dahiyat al Bared to the town of Ar Ram in order to complete Wall construction in the area. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to the village of Jaba', which connects the village to the cities of Jerusalem, Ramallah, and Jericho. • Checkpoint: The Israeli army continues to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and has designated a special crossing for holders of Jerusalem IDs and those possessing permits to access the city of Jerusalem. • Wall Gates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Ash Shayyah road in the area between the villages of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya and As Sawahira al Gharbiya, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices. • Wall Construction: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Bared, Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, west of the village of Al Jib, and in the vicinity of the village of Qatanna. • Arrest: The Israeli army arrested Iyad Badr az Zaghayyer in the old city of Jerusalem.
RAMALLAH & EL BIREH	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Main Roads: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the eastern entrance to the village of Sinjil as well as the road to the village of Ras Karkar. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the western entrance to the village of Saffa.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up on the overpass to the town of 'Atara and to impede civilian access. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the area west of the town of 'Abud as well as in the areas of Al Midya to Ni'lin and Ni'lin to Deir Qaddis. • <u>Raids/Detention:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 10:20, the Israeli army raided the town of Beituniya, set up a checkpoint on the junction to the town of 'Ein 'Arik, and searched civilians and vehicles. (ii) At 10:20, the Israeli army, including 2 jeeps, raided the city of El Bireh. At 00:25, the Israeli army raided the city again and patrolled the area until 02:30. (iii) At 15:00, the Israeli army, including 5 jeeps, raided the village of Saffa, searched 2 houses, and detained 1 civilian. (iv) At 02:20, the Israeli army raided the city of Ramallah, set up a checkpoint at its northern entrance, and searched civilians and vehicles.
JENIN	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the unpaved detour roads leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas, denying civilian access to the Northern Jordan Valley, except for civilians whose IDs indicate that their place of residence is the Northern Jordan Valley. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. (ii) Beginning on 29 March 2007, the Israeli army has continued to regulate times to open Al Jalama and Salim Wall gates between 06:30 until 10:00 and 17:00 until 21:00 respectively. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 24:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the towns of Tubas and Az Zababida as well as the villages of Sir and Al Far'a. (ii) At 07:30, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Jenin.
TULKAREM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to declare the district of Tulkarem a closed military zone and to impede civilian access to and from the district. • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the Dahiyat Iktaba-Bal'a road, the entrance to the village of Saffarin, the road connecting the town of Deir al Ghusun to 'Attil plain, the road connecting the town of Kafr al Labad to the village of Shufa, and the road to the town of Deir al Ghusun's plain. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Jubara checkpoint (the southern entrance to the city of Tulkarem) as well as at 'Einav checkpoint (the eastern entrance to the city). • <u>Wall Gates:</u> Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Flying Checkpoint/Detentions:</u> At 10:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the town of Bal'a, searched civilian vehicles, and detained 5 civilians. • <u>Raids/Provocation of Palestinian Forces/House Occupation/Attack/Injuries:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At dawn on 17 May 2007, the Israeli army raided the town of 'Illar, arrested 1 Palestinian General Intelligence officer, and withdrew at 10:30. (ii) At 10:15, the Israeli army raided Dahiyat Shuweika in the city of Tulkarem and patrolled the area until 12:25. (iii) At 19:50, the Israeli army raided the city of Tulkarem, after having demanded (through the DCO) that Palestinian security forces not leave their positions. The Israeli army also occupied the roof of a building and converted it into a military post. While searching a number of houses and an Internet café, confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians, during which the Israeli army injured 2 civilians, including 1 child. In addition, the Israeli army arrested 1 civilian as well as opened fire towards and damaged a vehicle belonging to a local television station. An armed confrontation also took place between the Israeli army and armed Palestinian individuals on the outskirts of Tulkarem refugee camp. At 00:30, the Israeli army withdrew from the area. (iv) At 20:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of 'Anabta. (v) At 22:45, Israeli troops, dispatched by a combat helicopter, raided the area between the towns of Bal'a and 'Illar, set up a checkpoint, and searched civilian and vehicles. • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army arrested Mohammed Hilmi Sissan, a Palestinian General Intelligence officer, in the town of 'Illar. (ii) The Israeli army arrested Shadi Fu'ad Qar'an in the city of Tulkarem.
QALQILIYA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the agricultural roads east of the town of 'Azzun. (ii) At 22:00, the Israeli army closed with cement blocks the northern entrance to the town of 'Azzun. • <u>Wall Gates:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and to search civilians, including students, with a metal detector. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Land levelling for Wall construction continues in the villages of Immatin and Kafr Laqif as well as east of the towns of Kafr Thulth and 'Azzun. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 17:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Immatin and searched civilians and vehicles.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Raids/Palestinian Attack:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 17:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the villages of ‘Asla and ‘Izbat at Tabib, after armed Palestinian individuals opened fire towards an Israeli settler vehicle and injured a female settler. (ii) At 23:00, the Israeli army, including 12 jeeps, raided the city of Qalqiliya, raided a plant nursery, and arrested 3 civilians. • <u>Arrests:</u> The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the city of Qalqiliya: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (iii) Mohammed Waseem ash Shanti; (iv) Shadi Ghaleb Mohammed al Walweel; and (v) Hussein Wajeel al Far.
NABLUS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the Jenin-Nablus road between the junction to the village of Deir Sharaf and the settlement of Shavei Shomron. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh as well as the southern entrance to the village of Qaryut. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to the village of Al Lubban ash Sharqiya with dirt barricades and cement blocks. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing checkpoints set up around the city of Nablus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Huwwara and Beit Iba checkpoints (set up at the southern and western entrances to the city of Nablus respectively) are closed at 23:00. The Israeli army only allows civilian vehicles possessing access permits to cross these checkpoints. The Israeli army also searches civilians using metal detectors at Beit Iba checkpoint, impeding their access. (ii) At Tur neighbourhood checkpoint (set up on Jirzim Mount) is closed on Fridays and Saturdays as well as during Jewish holidays. On all other days, it is open for civilian residents of the neighbourhood only. (iii) Beit Furik checkpoint is open to civilian residents of the town of Beit Furik and the village of Beit Dajan until 17:30. (iv) Beginning on 23 November 2006, the Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up in the area between the city of Nablus and the town of ‘Asira ash Shamaliya and to prevent civilians from crossing, only allowing access to humanitarian cases. (v) At 08:00, the Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Huwwara and Beit Iba checkpoints and denied access to civilians between 16 and 30 years of age. • <u>Raid:</u> At 23:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Nablus, searched 3 houses, arrested 3 civilians, and withdrew at 05:55. • <u>Arrests:</u> The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the city of Nablus: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Abdullah Ihsan an Nablisi; (ii) Mahmoud ‘Ashour; and (iii) ‘Adel Mohammed ash Shakhshir.

<p>SALFIT</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army has continued to close the main north-western entrance to the city of Salfit with dirt barricades since the beginning of the current <i>Intifada</i> (Uprising). (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the western entrance to the village of Marda and, with cement blocks, the western entrance to the town of Kafr ad Dik. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Deir Ballut checkpoint and to deny civilian access to the town of Kafr ad Dik. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the Za'tara junction checkpoint and to impede civilian access. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the city of Salfit, and in the village of Marda and the town of Kifl Haris north of the settlement of Ari'el. • <u>Raids:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 03:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Salfit, arrested 3 civilians, and withdrew at 04:30. (ii) At dawn, the Israeli army, including 5 jeeps, raided the village of Iskaka, searched 1 house, and arrested 2 civilians (brothers). • <u>Arrests:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 13:30, Israeli troops positioned at the Za'tara junction checkpoint arrested Sami Nasser Rajab, a Palestinian General Intelligence officer. <p>The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the city of Salfit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (ii) Anas Wassef az Zeer; (iii) Sameer Sameeh al Atrash; and (iv) 'Uthman Khalil 'Imran. <p>The Israeli army arrested 2 civilians in the village of Iskaka:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (v) Waleed Khaled Hussein Harb; and (vi) Ahmed Khaled Hussein Harb.
<p>JERICHO</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja with cement blocks and to prevent farmers not holding Jericho Governorate IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. The Israeli army also continues to deny access to the city to holders of Israeli IDs. • <u>Checkpoints:</u> The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions and impede civilian access at Al Hamra checkpoint set up along Al Badhan road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus as well as on the checkpoint set up on the junction to the village of Al 'Auja along Al Mu'arrajat road connecting the districts of Jericho and Ramallah. • <u>Arrest:</u> Israeli troops positioned on Al Karama (Allenby) Bridge arrested 'Azzam Mohammed Nasser, Chairman of Al 'Attara Village Council in the district of Jenin, while he was returning from Jordan.
<p>BETHLEHEM</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the detour roads leading to the town of Tuqu’. • <u>Checkpoint:</u> At 13:40, the Israeli army closed the DCO checkpoint set up at the western entrance to the city of Beit Jala, claiming that Israeli settlers were present along Road # 60 near the city of Beit Jala and the town of Al Khadr. The Israeli army reopened the checkpoint at a later time. • <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction continues in the area northwest of the town of Al Khadr, northwest of the city of Beit Jala, and in the area of Wadi Rahhal east of the settlement of Efrat. • <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 15:50, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the area of An Nashash south of the town of Al Khadr and searched civilians and vehicles. • <u>Raids/Attack/Injuries:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 12:50, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the city of Bethlehem. (ii) At 13:05, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Al Khadr. (iii) At 13:25, Israeli Special Forces raided the town of Al ‘Ubeidiya and arrested 2 civilians. (iv) At 15:30, the Israeli army raided the town of Beit Fajjar. While patrolling the area, confrontations took place between the Israeli army and civilians, during which the Israeli army injured 2 children. Of these, 15-year-old Jihad Khaled Taqatqah was in critical condition. • <u>Arrests:</u> Israeli Special Forces arrested 2 civilians in the town of Al ‘Ubeidiya: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Hilal Ahmed Rabay’ah; and (ii) Majed ‘Aqeel Rabay’ah. • <u>Settler Violence:</u> At 14:35, approximately 100 Israeli settlers gathered along Road # 60 near the area of An Nashash south of the town of Al Khadr.
HEBRON	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Closure:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the old city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada’ Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate; and the entrance to the area of Al Khan with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh. The Israeli army also continues to install an iron gate at the entrance to the area of Al Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) in the old city of Hebron, thereby controlling civilian access to and from the area. (ii) Although it expired on 07 May 2006, the Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the prohibition of civilian vehicles from travelling along the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba’ to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron unless they possess access permits.

- **Closure of Main Roads:**

- (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the following locales: the entrance to the town of As Samoa'; the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul; the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron; the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron; the road connecting the town of Surif to the village of Al Jab'a; the entrance to the village of Beit 'Einun; and the eastern entrance to the village of Kharsa. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron as well as the main entrance to Al 'Arrub refugee camp.
- (ii) In accordance with Military Order # 378, the Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling along Shalala Old Street that leads to the old city of Hebron, only allowing Israeli vehicles as well as Israeli army vehicles to travel along this street.

- **Wall Construction:** Wall construction continues in the section of Tarqumiya checkpoint terminal, the remaining section of the Wall route that separates the settlement of Eshkolot from the village of Ar Ramadin, and near the village of Imneizil southeast of the town of Yatta.

- **Flying Checkpoints/Detentions:**

- (i) At 16:30, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Beit Kahil and searched civilians and vehicles.
- (ii) At 21:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to Al Fawwar refugee camp and searched civilians and vehicles.

- **Raids/Confiscation of Property:**

- (i) At 10:30, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided and patrolled the town of Idhna.
- (ii) At 16:00, the Israeli army, including 3 jeeps, raided the city of Hebron, set up a checkpoint near Hebron University, and searched civilians and vehicles. At 20:00, the Israeli army raided the city again, set up a checkpoint in the area of Ras al Jora, searched civilians and vehicles, and patrolled the area. At 22:45, the Israeli army raided the city for the third time, raided a wedding hall, arrested 3 civilians, and confiscated 2 pieces of weapon.
- (iii) At 21:40, the Israeli army raided the town of Yatta. Confrontations took place between civilians and the Israeli army, while it was patrolling the area.
- (iv) At 01:00, the Israeli army raided and patrolled the town of Dura.

- **Arrests/Confiscation of Property:** At 23:00, the Israeli army arrested 3 civilians, after having confiscated a pistol from one of them, in the old city of Hebron:

- (i) Hussein Mohammed Abu Sneineh;
- (ii) Sameer 'Arafat Abu Sneineh; and
- (iii) Ja'far Abdul Raheem Abu Sneineh.

The Israeli army arrested 3 civilians in the city of Hebron:

- (iv) Fadi 'Areef Gheith;
- (v) Mousa Mutlaq ar Rajabi; and

	<p>(vi) Hisham 'Ashour.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demonstration/Detentions: At 13:00, a mass demonstration took place in the city of Hebron in protest against harsh living conditions resulting from the Israeli army's continued closure of Ash Shuhada' Street in the old city of Hebron. As protestors reached Ash Shuhada' Street, the Israeli army closed the gate installed at its entrance and detained civilians. After coordination with the Israeli authorities (through the DCO), the Israeli army released all detained civilians.

ALL DISTRICTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The ceasefire agreement that entered into force at 06:00 on 26 November 2006 remains effective.
NORTHERN GAZA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open to foreign nationals, humanitarian cases, and VIPs. • Attacks/Air Patrols/Provocation of Palestinian Forces: In violation of the Israeli-Palestinian ceasefire agreement, Israeli combat aircraft, army, and navy opened fire towards Palestinian territory, as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) At 11:45, Israeli combat helicopters opened machinegun fire towards Beit Hanun (Erez) Industrial Zone as well as towards 'Izbat Beit Hanun. (ii) At 12:10, Israeli combat helicopters opened machinegun fire towards Palestinian territory near Points 24 and 25 on the Green Line northeast of the town of Beit Hanun. (iii) At 17:35, Israeli combat helicopters opened machinegun fire towards the town of Beit Hanun, the area surrounding Hammoudeh gas station, and the area of Quleibu east of the town of Jabalya. (iv) At 18:50, the Israeli army fired 1 artillery shell from one of its locations inside the Green Line towards the entrance to the town of Beit Hanun. (v) At 19:35, the Israeli army fired 1 artillery shell from one of its locations inside the Green Line towards the area of Al 'Atatira west of the town of Beit Lahiya. (vi) At 22:30, the Israeli navy opened fire towards Palestinian fishing boats at sea opposite Al Waha beach northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya. (vii) At 23:40, the Israeli army fired 2 artillery shells from its locations on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory near Point 15 on the Green Line north of the town of Beit Lahiya. (viii) At 23:50, the Israeli army fired 1 tank shell from one of its locations on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory near Sheikh Zayed residential towers northeast of the town of Beit Lahiya. (ix) At 23:50, the Israeli army fired 4 tank shells from the area near Point 15 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory north of the town of Biet Lahiya. (x) At 00:15, the Israeli army fired 2 artillery shells from its locations inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory north of the town of Beit Lahiya.

- (xi) At 00:20, the Israeli army fired 3 artillery shells from its locations inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory near the offices of a Palestinian National Security Headquarters east of the town of Jabalya.
- (xii) At 06:00, Israeli combat helicopters opened machinegun fire towards 'Izbat Beit Hanun.
- (xiii) At 07:40, Israeli combat helicopters opened machinegun fire towards the area surrounding Sheikh Zayed residential towers.
- **Raids/Attacks/Land Levelling/House Occupation:** In violation of the Israeli-Palestinian ceasefire agreement, the Israeli army raided Palestinian territory, as follows:

 - (vii) At 19:00, the Israeli army, including 5 armoured vehicles, raided Palestinian territory near Point 20 on the Green Line north of the town of Beit Hanun.
 - (viii) At 19:20, the Israeli army, including 6 armoured vehicles and 1 bulldozer, raided 700 metres into Palestinian territory near the Green Line east of Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing north of the town of Beit Lahiya, levelled land and opened intensive fire.
 - (ix) At 19:30, the Israeli army, including 4 armoured vehicles and 1 bulldozer, raided 300 metres into Palestinian territory near Point 14 on the Green Line north of the town of Beit Lahiya, levelled land, and erected dirt barricades.
 - **Palestinian Attacks:** In violation of the Israeli-Palestinian ceasefire agreement, armed Palestinian individuals fired 12 mortars towards the Green Line, as follows:
 - (i) At 09:20, 2 unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line.
 - (ii) At 18:45, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.
 - (iii) At 19:30, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line.
