| <b>JERUSALEM</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b><u>Closure:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) On 19. 08. 2011 Israeli occupation forces tightened restrictions on the checkpoints at the entrances to the City and established many checkpoints at main road intersections and the entrances to the Aqsa Mosque Compound, and prevented citizens (with the exception of men over the age of 50 years and women over the age of 45 years and permit holders of men aged 45 years and 50 years old and women between the ages between 30 years and 45 years old) from entering the city Also flow a zeppelin with a camera a helicopter above the Al-Aqsa Mosque Compound to monitor the worshipers.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ based on military order T/02/09, along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Ikksa villages.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Closure of Main Roads:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.</li> <li>(iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Ikksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Checkpoints:</u></b> Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.</li> <li>• <b><u>Fire Attacks:</u></b> At 11:00, Israeli forces fired in the area of the Damascus Gate at the entrance of old city of Jerusalem, sound bombs at a number of citizens, and severely beating Palestinians during their protest from preventing them from entering and praying in Al Aqsa Mosque.</li> <li>• <b><u>Destruction of property:</u></b> At 13:00, Israeli forces stationed in the vicinity of Qalandia checkpoint, caused damages to a car owned by Wissam Michel Al Sayegh, while he was near the checkpoint.</li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Gates:</u></b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.</li> <li>(ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al-Sawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• <b><u>Wall Construction:</u></b> Wall construction resumed in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za’ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma’ale Adumim.</li> </ul> |

These assaults resulted killed 4 members of Palestinian armed groups while a fifth casualty died of previous wounds; 21 citizens were also injured (including 2 children and 4 members of armed Palestinian groups).</li> <li>• Armed Palestinian groups violated the cease-fire, launching 35 projectiles towards the Green Line.</li> </ul>  |
