ALL DISTRICTS	• Beginning on 17 April 2006, the Israeli army has intensified the complete closure imposed over the West Bank and Gaza Strip districts after a Palestinian individual carried out a suicide attack in the city of Tel Aviv inside the Green Line. The Israeli army has continued to prevent civilians with permits, including workers, from crossing into areas inside the Green Line or into the city of Jerusalem.

JERUSALEM	 <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrances to the city of Jerusalem, in the old city of Jerusalem, and around AI Aqsa Mosque compound. <u>Closure of Main Roads</u>: (i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance opposite the junction to Dahiyat AI Bareed in the city of Jerusalem with a checkpoint and barbed wire. The Israeli army denies civilian access, only allowing civilians residing behind the Wall and those holding Jerusalem-issued IDs to cross on foot. (ii) The Israeli army closed the eastern entrance to Dahiyat Bir Nabala with cement slabs, thereby completing the Wall section in the area. <u>Checkpoints</u>: (i) Beginning on 04 April 2006, the Israeli army has implemented new measures at Qalandiya checkpoint, after having declared it a "border crossing point." The Israeli army designated a special crossing for civilians holding Jerusalem. The Israeli army has allowed other civilians to access the main road leading to the junction to the village of Jaba', which branches off to other districts. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close Beit Iksa (Ramot) checkpoint, denying access to civilian vehicles. <u>Wall Gates</u>: The Israeli army continues to close the Wall gate in the town of Abu Dis with cement blocks. <u>Wall Goustruction</u>: Wall construction continues in Dahiyat al Aqbat, from the village of Hizma to 'Anata, along the Hizma-Jaba' road, the area of Al 'Eizariya to Ash Shayyah, near Al Quds University, in the town of As Sawahira ash Sharqiya, from the village of Beit Surik to Biddu, in the areas of Al Judeira, Bir Nabala, and Beit Hanina, and west of the village of Al Jib.

JENIN	 <u>Closure of Road</u>: The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the unpaved detour road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the settlement of Dotan. <u>Checkpoint</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Tayasir checkpoint east of the town of Tubas and to deny access to civilians under 30 years of age. <u>Wall Gates</u>: Passage through the Wall gates is restricted to civilians granted special Israeli permits. <u>Flying Checkpoint</u>: At 08:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint at the entrance to the town of Tubas and searched civilians and vehicles. <u>Raids/Provocation of Palestinian Forces</u>: (i) At 12:45, the Israeli army, including 4 jeeps, raided the city of Jenin and patrolled the area until 13:20.

TULKAREM	 <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to impose a complete closure on the district of Tulkarem and to declare it a closed military zone following a suicide attack carried out on the junction to the village of Far'un. The Israeli army continues to impede civilian access to and from the district. <u>Closure of Main Roads</u>: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the roads connecting the following locales: Dahiyat Iktaba in the city of Tulkarem and the town of Bal'a; Dahiyat Dhinnaba in the city of Tulkarem and the town of Kafr al Labad; Dahiyat Dhinnaba and the village of 'Izbat Abu Khamish; the town of Kafr al Labad and the village of Shufa; the towns of Deir al Ghusun and 'Attil; and the towns of Deir al Ghusun and Bal'a. The Israeli army also continues to close with cement blocks the road connecting the town of Baqa ash Sharqiya with dirt barricades. <u>Checkpoints</u>:

The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades Al Badhan road, which is the north-eastern entrance to the city of Nablus and connects the city to the district of Jenin.
NABLUS	 <u>Checkpoints</u>: (i) The Israeli army continues to regulate times for crossing Huwwara, Beit Iba, At Tur Mountain, and Beit Furik checkpoints around the city of Nablus. The Israeli army closes the checkpoints overnight and reopens them at various morning hours. (ii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at Huwwara checkpoint and to deny access to civilians between 15 and 30 years of age. Flying Checkpoint/Destruction of Property: The Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint near the town of 'Aqraba, searched civilians and vehicles, and the upper the fibric device.

JERICHO	 <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to intensify the closure imposed over the city of Jericho and to close Road # 90 between the city of Jericho and the village of Al 'Auja with cement blocks. The Israeli army also prevents farmers not holding Jericho-issued IDs from reaching their land, forcing them to apply for access permits. In addition, the Israeli army prevents civilians holding Jerusalem-issued IDs, Israeli citizens, and civilians from other districts from entering the city of Jericho. The Israeli army has also prevented civilians holding Jericho-issued IDs from leaving the city. <u>Checkpoints</u>: (i) The Israeli army intensified its restrictions at Al Hamra checkpoint set up on the road connecting the districts of Jericho and Nablus and denied access to civilians under 30 years of age. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the DCO checkpoint set up at the southern entrance to the city of Jericho and to deny civilian access in both directions, only allowing vehicles bearing Israeli-issued license plates to exit the city. (iii) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at the checkpoint set up at the entrance to the village of 'Ein ad Duyuk, to deny civilian access to the city of Jericho, and to prevent civilians holding Jericho-issued IDs from leaving the city. Israeli troops positioned at the checkpoint only allow civilians from other districts to exit the city of Jericho. (iv) The Israeli army continues to close the checkpoint set up near the settlement of Yitav west of the village of Al 'Auja, denying civilian access. <u>Raids/Air Patrol</u>: (i) At 07:00, the Israeli army, including 19 jeeps, raided 'Aqbat Jaber refugee camp, whilst combat helicopters patrolled the skies over the area. The Israeli army searched 2 houses and withdrew at 05:00. (ii) At 07:00, the Israeli army, including 1 tank and 4 armoured vehicles, raided the area southeast of the city of Jericho, set up a checkpoint, and denied access to ci
BETHLEHEM	 <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to close the roads to the village of An Nu'man, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. The Israeli army considers the civilians' residence in the village illegal because they hold West Bank identity cards while their village is located within the Israeli-defined municipal boundaries of Jerusalem. <u>Closure of Main Roads</u>: The Israeli army continues to close all roads to Road # 60 leading to the city of Jerusalem, thereby isolating the city of Bethlehem from its towns and villages located west of Road # 60. <u>Wall Construction</u>: Wall construction continues north of 'Ayda refugee camp and in the Everest area, northwest of the city of Beit Jala. <u>Raids</u>: (i) At 10:45, an Israeli army patrol raided the city of Beit Jala and patrolled the area.

	 (ii) At 11:20, an Israeli army patrol raided the city of Bethlehem and patrolled the area. At 16:15, the Israeli army, including 12 jeeps, raided the city again, searched 1 house, and arrested 1 civilian. At 02:00, the Israeli army raided the city for the third time and patrolled the area. 	 (ii) The Israeli army arrested Ridha Salem Khalil 'Ubayyat in the town of Tuqu'. (iii) The Israeli army arrested Tareq 'Adel 'Ata Allah, a Palestinian Civil Defence officer, in the village of Harmala.
HEBRON	 <u>Closure</u>: The Israeli army continues to close the following locales in the H2 section of the city of Hebron: Ash Shuhada' Street and the area of As Sahleh with cement blocks and barbed wire; the old gold market with an iron gate; and the area of Khuzq al Far near the settlement of Abraham Avino with a dirt barricade and an iron gate. The Israeli army also continues to close the entrance to the area of Al Khan in the old city of Hebron with an electronic gate, isolating the area from Al Laban Market and the area of As Sahleh. (ii) The Israeli army continues to implement a military order stipulating the closure of civilian commercial shops on both sides of the road connecting the settlement of Kiryat Arba' to the Ibrahimi Mosque in the old city of Hebron from 06 November 2005 until 07 May 2006. Civilian vehicles are prohibited from travelling along the road unless they possess access permits. Only Israeli settler vehicles are allowed unrestricted access on the road.
	 (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt barricades the area of Al Hawawir leading to the town of Halhul, the area of Al Fahs south of the city of Hebron, the junction to the area of Farsh al Hawa leading to Road # 35 northwest of the city of Hebron, and the entrance to the village of 'Arab ar Ramadin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the entrance to Al Qeisi neighbourhood in the old city of Hebron with cement blocks. (iii) The Israeli army continues to close Road # 60 connecting the districts of Hebron and Bethlehem and to deny civilian access, forcing civilians to travel along the alternative road that passes through Tuqu' and Sa'ir to Hebron.

	Wall Construction: Wall construction continues west of the towns of Surif and Beit Ula, south of the towns of Adh Dhahiriya and As Samoa', and southeast of the town of Yatta. The Israeli army has also completed construction of most sections of the Wall in the town of Idhna, from the village of Deir Samit to the town of Beit 'Awwa, from Beit 'Awwa to the village of Al Burj, and in the village of Ar Ramadin. Flying Checkpoints: At 08:30, and again at 13:15, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint
	on the road to the town of Beit Kahil, searched civilians and vehicles, and impeded civilian access.
(ii)	At 09:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on Al Fawwar junction, searched civilians and vehicles, and impeded civilian access.

(v)	At 14:25, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint on the junction to the village of Kharsa and searched civilians and vehicles.
(vi)	At 15:00, the Israeli army set up a flying checkpoint in the area of Sinjir between the city of Hebron and the town of Dura and searched civilians and vehicles.
•	Raids/Detentions/Provocation of Palestinian Forces:
(i)	At 13:30, the Israeli army raided the city of Hebron, set up a checkpoint in the area of Al Hawuz al Awwal, searched civilian vehicles, and detained 1 Palestinian Police officer. At 15:15, the Israeli army raided the city again, set up a checkpoint in the area of Al Hawuz ath Thani, and patrolled the area.

NORTHERN GAZA	 continued to impose a buffer zone (through open fire as well as artillery and air attacks) in the area near the Green Line, including the area of the debris of evacuated settlements. Closure of Crossing Point: Beit Hanun (Erez) Crossing is partially open to foreign nationals, VIPs, and humanitarian cases after prior coordination. Attacks/Provocation of Palestinian Forces: Between 08:00 and 20:15, the Israeli army fired 175 artillery shells from its location inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory near 5 Palestinian National Security locations, in the area surrounding the sewage basins, and in the areas of Al Wadi and Al Farta north and northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya. Other artillery shells landed in Al Ghabun neighbourhood west of the town of Beit Lahiya and near a Palestinian National Security Headquarters in the town of Beit Hanun. As a result, 1 civilian was injured. Between 22:00 and 23:50, the Israeli army fired 42 artillery shells from its location inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory north and northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya. (ii) Between 22:00 and 23:50, the Israeli army fired 42 artillery shells from its location inside the Green Line towards Palestinian territory north and northwest of the town of Beit Lahiya. (iii) At 01:40, the Israeli army opened fire from Point 24 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory east of the town of Beit Hanun. Air Patrol: At 20:45, an Israeli army reconnaissance aircraft patrolled the skies over the northern area in the district of Northern Gaza. Palestinian Attacks: (i) At 10:10, 2 unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line, of which 1 mortar exploded in the area from which it was launched. (ii) At 02:00, 2 unidentified mortars were fired towards the Green Line, of which 1 mortar exploded in the area from which it was launched.

KHAN YUNIS	 <u>Attacks</u>: At 22:30, the Israeli army opened fire and fired a number of flares from Point 176 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory east of the village of 'Abasan al Kabira. At 22:55, the Israeli army opened fire from the area between Points 164 and 177 on the Green Line towards Palestinian territory east of the village of 'Abasan al Kabira. <u>Palestinian Attack</u>: At 02:00, 1 unidentified mortar was fired towards the Green Line, but landed on Palestinian territory.
RAFAH	 <u>Closure of Crossing Points</u>: Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah Crossing is partially open in both directions to passengers holding Palestinian IDs, humanitarian cases, and Arab and foreign diplomatic missions. Sufa Crossing is closed.
