## WEST BANK

## JERUSALEM

- **Closure:**
  - (i) On November 22<sup>nd</sup> 2013 Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road leading to the city and prevented worshippers under the age of 50 from conducting prayers at Al-Aqsa mosque compound.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the ‘demarcation area’ along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.
  - (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.
- **Closure of Main Roads:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba’ village.
  - (ii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandiya checkpoint.
- **Checkpoints:**
  - (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a “border crossing point” and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city and at 06:00, Israeli forces closed the checkpoint impeding the free flow of traffic.
  - (ii) On September 19<sup>th</sup> 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu’fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall.
- **Raid:** At 13:00, Israeli forces raided Abu Dis and clashed with its residents.
- **Temporary Detention:** On November 22<sup>nd</sup> 2013, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Sa’aydeh neighbourhood in the old city of Jerusalem temporarily detained 4 children: Fadi Al-Ghafri (10 years old), Mohammad Naji (14 years old), Abdel Rahman Hijazi (8 years old) and Ahmad Jabour (10 years old) then released them at a later time.
- **Physical Assault:** At 16:40, Israeli forces positioned near Hata gate in the old city of Jerusalem assaulted Omar Salameh leaving him injured with contusion.
- **Attack:**
  - (i) At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at Qalandiya checkpoint fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (ii) At 16:20, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Isawiya fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents for alleged stoning
  - (iii) At 17:00, Israeli forces positioned at Al-Ram junction fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
  - (iv) At 21:35, Israeli forces positioned at Abu Dis fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning near the wall gate.
- **Demonstration:** At 17:10, a demonstration took place in Al-Shiekh Jarrah neighbourhood in Jerusalem protesting against seizing and confiscation of homes for the purpose settlement activity.
- **Wall Gates:**
  - (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
