	 <u>Closure:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to intensify its restrictions at checkpoints located at the entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main
JERUSALEM	 road leading to the city. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local residents as well as to civilians holding special permits. (iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a
	 hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages. <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the gate along the Wall section separating the area of Dahiyat Al-Bareed from Al-Ram town.
	 (iii) The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the eastern entrance to Beit Iksa village and forces civilians to access Jerusalem city through Qalandia checkpoint. Checkpoints:
	 (i) Israeli authorities continue to consider Qalandiya checkpoint a "border crossing point" and designate a special crossing lane for holders of Jerusalem IDs and another for those possessing permits to access Jerusalem city.
	 (ii) On September 19th 2012, Israeli forces closed Ras Khamis checkpoint near Shu'fat camp and impeded the free flow of traffic in order to construct the wall. (iii) At 10:30, Israeli forces increased its restrictions at Ja'aba checkpoint, searched vehicles with bomb sniffing dogs and impeded the free flow of traffic.

	 <u>Temporary Detention</u>: At 22:00, Israeli forces positioned near the International Red Cross headquarters in Al-Sheikh Jarrah neighbourhood temporarily detained 30 demonstrators participating in demonstration in solidarity with Palestinian detainees and demanding their release from Israeli prisons. <u>Destruction of Property</u>: On December 22nd 2012, Israeli forces served demolition orders to demolish 5 barracks in North Jerusalem for allegedly not having proper construction licencing. <u>Assault on Places of Worship</u>: At 09:30, Israeli settlers under the protection of Israeli forces stormed Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in the old city of Jerusalem and provoked worshipers. <u>Settler Violence</u>: On December 22nd 2012, Israeli settlers attempted to prevent residents from lighting a Christmas tree in the old city of Jerusalem near Bab Al-Jadid gate. <u>Wall Gates</u>: (i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks the Wall gate in Abu Dis town.
	 (ii) The Israeli army continues to deny civilian access through the Wall gate on Al-Shayyah road in the area between Al-Sawahira Al-Sharqiya and Al- Sleavawahira Al-Gharbiya villages, only allowing civilians holding Jerusalem IDs to cross, after subjecting them to thorough searches using electronic devices.
	 <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in the areas north and south of Qalandiya village; south of Al-Za'ayyem village; and in Wadi Al-Eizariya west of the illegal settlement Ma 'ale Adumim for Sabbath holiday. <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u> The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to

	alleged stoning of an Israeli settlers vehicle along the road connecting
	Nablus and Qalqiliya until 14:00.

	 <u>Wall Construction:</u> Wall construction was halted in Kafr Laqif village north

	demanding their release from Israeli prisons.
	• Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in North West of Beit Jala
	town for Sabbath holiday.
	<u>Closure:</u>
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close Al-Shuhada' Street, Al-Sahleh and Khuzq
	Al-Far areas, as well as the old gold market in Hebron's Old City. In addition
	to closing the entrance to Al-Qeisi neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues
	to close the entrances to the area of Al-Hisba (the fruits and vegetables
	market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market also remains closed.
	(ii) Since 05 January 2009, the Israeli army has closed the area located along the
	Green Line south of the town of Yatta. Having seized land for Wall
	construction, the Israeli army evicted the Palestinian residents and denied them
	access to the area.
	Closure of Main Roads:
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the entrances to Al-Thahiriya and Al-
	Samoa' towns, Al-'Arrub refugee camp, and Al-Tuwani and Al-Karmil
	villages.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to prohibit Palestinian vehicles from travelling
	along the old Al-Shalala Street leading to Hebron's Old City.
	(iii) The Israeli army continues to close all roads leading to Road # 60 as well as
	detour roads along the settler bypass road leading to Yatta town.
	(iv) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds a detour road leading to
	the entrance to Al-Simiya village, the southern entrance of Al-Samou' and the
	entrance of Beit Annun with cement blocks.
	(v) On July 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the road connecting Al-Safa and Al-Dirat
	and also closed the entrance of south Yatta with cement blocks
	• <u>Raid:</u>
	(i) At 08:00, Israeli forces raided Dura and set up a checkpoint.
HEBRON	(ii) At 08:40 and again at dawn on December 23rd 2012 Israeli forces raided
	Hebron and detained a resident.
	(iii) At 19:10, Israeli forces raided Al-Urub camp and clashed with residents
	as they stormed a home.
	(iv) At dawn on December 23rd 2012, Israeli forces raided Beit Ummar,
	stormed 2 homes and detained 2 residents.
	• <u>Attack</u> : At 16:00, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Beit Ummar
	fired rubber coated steel bullets and tear gas grenades towards residents
	participating in funeral precisions for alleged stoning, injured 3 residents Nizar
	Awad, Omar Awad and Ahmad Awad including 2 from live ammunition and 1
	from a rubber coated steel bullet) as well as leaving several other suffocated from
	tear gas inhalation.
	• <u>Detention:</u>
	(i) At 12:00, Israeli forces detained Azmi Al-Shimati, Mohammad Al-
	Shimati and Issa Al-Shimati a near Al-Swiesiya village located south of

Yatta and assaulted Mohammad Batash leaving him hospitalised with
contusions.
(ii) Israeli forces detained Mohamamd Taha in Yatta.
(iii) Israeli forces detained Ali Khalil and Mo'ayad Al-Titi in Beit Ummar.
• Demonstration: At 12:30, a demonstration took place near agricultural land
in Beit Ummar protesting settler violence and the prevention of Palestinian
farmers from reaching their agricultural land during which Israeli forces assaulted
several demonstrators and temporarily detained Qusay Abu Hashim(15 years old)
and Taysir Salibi (13 years old) releasing them at a later time.
• Wall Construction: Wall construction was halted in the area surrounding
the illegal settlement Eshkolot, west of Al-Thahriya town for Sabbath holiday.

ALL DISTRICTS	 At 21:00 on November 21st 2012, the unilateral ceasefire declared by Israel came into effect. At a later time on the same day, armed Palestinian groups announced an agreement to cease fire. On November 24th 2012, Israeli forces placed floating marks 3 miles from Gaza's seashore and warned fishermen against passing beyond the mark.

GAZA	 <u>Closure of Crossing Points:</u> Al-Muntar (Karni) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 02 March 2011, the Crossing has been effectively closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. Al-Shija'iya (Nahal 'Oz) Crossing is closed. Beginning on 04 January 2010, the Crossing has been closed following a unilateral Israeli decision. 		
RAFAH	 <u>Closure of Crossing Points :</u> Yasser 'Arafat International Airport remains closed. Rafah (<i>Al 'Awdah</i>) Crossing is open for the exit of patients, students, passengers with permits and International aid including 42 tons of Humanitarian aid (50 tents, 4000 blankets, 10 tons of canned meat and 10 tons of powdered milk) from Russia. Sufa Crossing is closed. Karm Abu Salem (Karem Shalom) Crossing is closed.
