	(i) On July 24 th 2015 the Israeli army, intensified their restrictions at the
	entrance to Jerusalem city, set up several flying checkpoints on the main road
	leading to the city and prevented worshipers from conducting prayers in Al- Aqsa mosque compound except for Women over the age of 55, Permit holders
	and men ages 50.
	(ii) The Israeli army continues to close the 'demarcation area' along the Wall in
	the area surrounding occupied East Jerusalem and restricts access to local
	residents as well as to civilians holding special permits.(iii) The Israeli army continues to impose a blockade and deny civilian access to a
	hill between Biddu and Beit Iksa villages.
	<u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with cement blocks and dirt mounds the entrance to Jaba' village.

	• Raid: At 19:45, Israeli forces raided Al-Eisawiya village, clashed with several
	residents, fired stun, and tear gas grenades and as a result set fire to home furniture
	 after a tear gas grenade exploded in a home owned by Abu Rayala family. Detention: At 19:45, Israeli forces detained Obada Najib in the old city of
	Jerusalem.
	• Attack: At 14:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Magharba gate (A main gate
	entrance leading to Al-Aqsa mosque compound) in the old city of Jerusalem fired
	stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning.
	• <u>Expulsion</u> : On July 25 th 2015, Israeli forces released nine residents (who were detained in the old city of Jerisalem): Mohammad Abu Farha, Mohammad Al-
	Bassati, Eyad Al-Khoukh, Omar Ibrahim, Ahmad Al-Shawish, Abdallah Da'na,
	Mahmoud Al-Shawish, Waheed Bakri and Ma'moun Ghayth after they were

	 for a period of 7 days. <u>Settler Violence</u>: On the afternoon of July 24th 2015, an Israeli settler attempted to

(ii) At 21:40 on June 30th 2015, Israeli forces closed the main road near "Bet El" settlement, which leads to Al-Jalazoun camp with cement blocks. <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u> At 13:35, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint near Atara bridge in North Bir Ziet and detained a resident <u>Detention:</u> Israeli forces detained Mohammad Al-Loulou at a checkpoint near Atara Bridge in North Bir Ziet. <u>Attack:</u> At 19:40, Israeli forces positioned at the entrance of Al-Jalazoun camp fired rubber coated steel bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards several residents for alleged stoning. <u>Demonstrations:</u> (i) At 13:30, a demonstration took place in Bil'in protesting against the construction of the wall during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several residents suffocated from tear gas inhalation. (ii) At 13:35, a demonstration took place in Al-Nabi Saleh village protesting against the confiscation of land for the purpose of settlement construction during which they clashed with Israeli forces and as a result left several resident suffocated from tear gas inhalation.
JENIN	 <u>Closure of Main Road:</u> (i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the road leading to the town of 'Arraba east of the illegal settlement Dotan. (ii) Since the evening of November 25th 2012, Israeli forces closed the western entrance of Ya'bad. <u>Raid:</u> At 13:35, Israeli forces raided Ya'bad. <u>Temporary Detention:</u> At 02:20, Israeli forces positioned in Al-Sahil area in Ya'bad temporarily detained Firas Al-Abbadi (A resident of Ya'bad) then released him later. <u>Wall Gates:</u> Israeli forces continue too close the wall gate and only allow those holding special permits to enter through it.
TULKAREM	 <u>Checkpoint:</u> Israeli forces intensified their restrictions at "Eniv" checkpoint and impeded the free flow of traffic. <u>Raid:</u> At 02:45, Israeli forces raided Deir Al-Ghusoun until 06:15. <u>Attack:</u> At 02:20, Israeli forces positioned near the wall gate in Deir Al-Ghusoun opened fire towards two residents and as a result injured Hatem Ghannam and Ahmad Ghanam leaving them hospitalised with contusions. <u>Closure of Roads:</u> (i) Israeli forces continue to close with cement blocks agricultural roads east of Azzun town.

QALQILIYA	(ii) In addition to closing the gate installed since the outbreak the second Intifada, the Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the eastern entrance to Kafr Qaddum village.
	(iii) Since 16:55 on December 18th 2014, Israeli forces closed an agricultural road leading to Far'ata village which is located near "Gillad" settlement
	 with dirt mounds Flying Checkpoint: At 10:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Kafr Qaddum village.
	• <u>Raid:</u>
	 (i) At 12:10, Israeli forces raided Kafr Qaddum village, occupied Abdel— Latif Al-Qaddumi's home and converted its rooftop into a military post then withdrew at 15:15.
	(ii) At 01:10, Israeli forces raided Hajja village, summoned four residents: Ahmad Tayoun, Mohammad Tayoun, Manar Basalat and Mohammad Basalat to report to Israeli Intelligence for questioning.
	• Demonstration: At 12:30, a demonstration took place in Kafr Qaddum against the closure of the east entrance during which they clashed with Israeli forces who tried
	to disrupt the demonstration who fired live ammunition, rubber coated steel
	bullets, stun and tear gas grenades towards demonstrators who attempted to reach they demonstration site and as a result injured Mohammad Ishtewi (13 years old) and left several others suffocating form tear gas inhalation.
	 <u>Wall Gates:</u>
	 (i) The Israeli army continues to restrict access at 'Azzun 'Atma Wall gate and impeded the free flow of traffic. The Israeli army continues to close with an iron gate the entrance to the village of Wadi Al- Rasha and to
	deny civilian access.
	(ii) The Israeli army allows residents to access the village through Gate #109. Having removed the gate at the entrance to the village of Ras Atiya; the Israeli army only allows students to cross to their schools outside the village through the Habla gate.
	• <u>Closure</u> : Since December 17 th 2013, Israeli forces ordered the closure 500
	dunumes of land in Qusra village as a closed military area.
	• <u>Closure of Main Roads:</u>
	(i) The Israeli army continues to close the roads of Til-Burin and Beit Furik- Salem; the settler bypass road connecting the village of Deir al Hatab to the settlement of Alon Moreh; the road connecting the town of 'Aqraba to the village of Osrin; and the detour road between the town of Qabalan and the
	 village of Osrin. (ii) The Israeli army continues to close the northern entrance to Qabalan town; the southern entrances to the town of Jamma'in and the villages of Duma and
	Qaryut.
	• <u>Flying Checkpoint:</u>
NABLUS	 (i) At 13:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Burin village until 16:45.
	(ii) At 16:30, Israeli forces set up a checkpoint at the entrance of Beit Dajjan until 17:15.
	(iii) At 16:40, Israeli force set up a checkpoint near "Shave Shomron" settlement junction until 17:00.
	• Raid: At 23:00, Israeli forces raided Einbuis village until 24:00.

SALFIT	(i) The Israeli army continues to close with dirt mounds the entrance to two detour roads connecting Marda village to its farmland.
	(ii) On 15.04.2012, the Israeli army has opened the northern entrance to Salfit city to civilian, which was closed since the year 2000 and prevented access from

	 08:00 until 09:20. (iii) Since 11:00 on July 30th 2012, Israeli forces have closed two roads leading to Abu Nasar and Qatan Al-Jama' located in western area of Deir Istiya with cement blocks. Checkpoints: At 00:55, Israeli forces continue to intensify their restrictions at Za'tara checkpoint and imped the free flow of traffic until 01:45.
JERICHO	 <u>Checkpoints</u>: Israeli forces intensified its restrictions at Al-Hamra checkpoint set up along the road connecting Jericho and Nablus District. <u>Physical Assault</u>: At 08:00, Israeli forces positioned near Al-Shalalat area in Al-Oja village assaulted Haytham Haran as he was herding his sheep in the area.
BETHLEHEM	 Closure: The Israeli army continues to close roads to An Nu'man village, with the exception of the road leading to the Wall gate in the south-eastern area of the village. Since 15 September 2007, the Israel army has prevented civilians from accessing or staying on 22 dunumes of confiscated land in Al Mazmuriya area in Beit Sahur and Bethlehem cities. 	neighbourhood, the Israeli army continues to close the entrances to the area of Al-
	Hisba (the fruits and vegetables market) with an electronic gate; Al-Laban Market
	also remains closed.
